Meet the Poster Artist



The 2021 featured artist is local artist, Linda Scott, a staple of the Eastern Shore art scene for many years.

She says she doesn't have to travel far to find inspiration. "It's the whole Eastern Shore from Spanish Fort to Daphne to Fairhope, all the way down to Point Clear, you don't have a place like this just anywhere. There's never a day that there's not beauty along this shoreline."

She specifically recalls moving to the area 18 years ago. "We came over the hill and had the panorama of the bay in front of us, my husband and I looked at each other and said, 'and we live here,' said Scott, explaining that this year's featured artwork showcases Mobile Bay and all that makes this place wonderful.

The colors in her painting reflect the setting sun at May Day Park in Daphne. "It was about sunset, so I was able to capture the colors we get in the sunset here, captured the trees with the Spanish moss on it. There's usually a heron or an egret down there."

It's not uncommon to see local wildlife popping up in Linda's paintings. She's known locally for her birds, crabs and oysters.

The 33rd Annual Jubilee Festival of Arts is proud to have Linda represent us in 2021 with her beautiful work.

Festival History

The Jubilee Festival is two exciting days filled with arts, crafts, food, entertainment and fun all taking place on the streets of downtown Daphne, aptly called "The Jubilee City." The Eastern Shore Chamber of Commerce hosts this wonderful event each year in cooperation with the City of Daphne. The Festival is growing each year and is enticing many new exhibitors as well as old favorites to the event and the Eastern Shore.

The Jubilee Festival was created as a way to combine business, tourism and fun while showcasing the City of Daphne. The first planning committee selected the name Jubilee Festival due to the Jubilee phenomenon that occurs in areas around Mobile Bay and most frequently on the Eastern Shore.



Antiques were featured during the first Jubilee Festival which was held in November 1989. During that first year, Main Street in Olde Towne Daphne was transformed into an "Antique Alley" with 60 vendor booths. In addition to antiques, there were arts and crafts booths as well as food and entertainment.

Much of this continues today, except that antiques are no longer featured. The Jubilee Festival is a juried visual arts and crafts festival that currently features many artists and crafters from the local area and Southeast region along with entertainment, food court and Kids Art Park.

In 2017, the festival changed its name to the Jubilee Festival of Arts, highlighting its expanding focus on all aspects of art. The Chamber added Southern Makers demonstrations & partnered with the World Food Championships to offer two qualifier competitions.

The festival embraced a new logo for its 30th Anniversary and added the Jubilee

Market and Chef Demonstrations in 2019.



In 2020, the festival moved to Lott Park to allow room for social distancing during the COVID-19 Pandemic. It also made a move to October due to Hurricane Sally. People loved October's cooler weather and Lott Park so much, the committee chose to keep the moves in 2021.

The Jubilee Festival of Arts has become an Eastern Shore tradition offering fun and excitement for visitors of all ages. The Eastern Shore Chamber of Commerce is pleased to provide this honored event for local residents and visitors.


