The event will be hosted at the Ponte Vedra Concert Hall from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. and will feature a straw poll so that you can cast a vote for whomever won your confidence during the evening. Politics in St. Johns to be held July 16 at Ponte Vedra Concert Hall

On Monday, July 16, candidates for local, state and national public offices will meet with hundreds of residents during the St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce's Politics in St. Johns event at the Ponte Vedra Concert Hall.

Beginning at 5:30 p.m., this free event will feature candidates for state senator, state representative, county commission and candidates seeking election to the U.S. Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, the governor's office and many others. As part of the event, all attendees will be able to support their favorite candidates by voting in a straw poll managed by Vicky Oakes and the office of the St. Johns County Supervisor of Elections.

"We are so proud to be able to bring these events every two years to the residents of St. Johns County," said Isabelle Renault, president and CEO of the St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce. "This event grows every election year and we want to encourage as many people as we can to join us to meet the candidates that they will be voting for in the upcoming elections."

According to Bob Porter, the Chamber's director of public policy, the straw poll results aren't necessarily reflective of what will happen when the official polls open at the end of August, but they do add excitement to the event and immediate feedback to participating candidates.

"The straw poll is less about who wins and more about encouraging and providing people incentive to be informed," he said. "I hope to see many people taking advantage of this opportunity that will help them make an informed decision when entering the voting booth."

On Aug. 1, beginning at 5 p.m., the Chamber will host a Politics in St. Johns Meet the Candidates event in St. Augustine at the Solomon Calhoun Center. The format will mirror the Ponte Vedra event. It will include a meet and greet with the candidates and their representatives and a straw poll.




