LOOKING AHEAD: 2018 PONTE VEDRA AUTO SHOW

16th annual event boasts new Nocatee location, anniversary celebrations and a racing legend

This year's Ponte Vedra Auto Show will celebrate several car anniversaries, welcome a new location, and, unlike last year, avoid a hurricane.

The 16th annual Ponte Vedra Auto Show, hosted by the St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce, will take place on Sunday, Sept. 9, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Spray Park event field in Nocatee.

"We're in a new, exciting location and hopefully our permanent home for the Auto Show moving forward," said Toni Boudreaux, director of the Chamber's Ponte Vedra Beach Division and show official. "More space, more parking, more everything, so we're really excited for that."

Having the event in Nocatee is also a plus for the event's title sponsor, Fields Auto Group.

"For us, that's a great area," Garry Redig, vice president of operations for Fields Auto Group, said. "We have a tremendous amount of our customers living in that area."

The Auto Show, which is open and free to spectators, will showcase "up to 180 classic and new collectors' cars vying for the show's 30-plus trophies," according to the event's website.

There will also be four special anniversary celebrations honoring the Best in Show 70th anniversary of the Porsche 356, Best in Show 50th anniversary of the Subaru, Best in Show 40th anniversary of the Mazda RX-7 and Best in Show 60th anniversary of the Austin-Healey.

Another addition to this year's show is the opportunity to meet a racing legend. Hurley Haywood, a popular Porsche driver who had five victories in the Rolex 24 at Daytona before retiring from racing in 2012, released his book "Hurley: From the Beginning" earlier this year and will be on hand to greet fans. (Read pages 21 and 22 for more information.)

There will also be more than 30 vendors, food trucks, a firetruck for the children and plenty of giveaways and prizes, including the chance to win a luxury car from Fields Auto Group.

Redig said the Ronald McDonald House will be selling raffle tickets to win one of five cars from Fields. The options consist of a Jaguar XE, Land Rover Discovery Sport, Cadillac ATS, Mercedes CLA or a Lexus UX. Proceeds will support the Ronald McDonald House.



About this year's judges

Winners of the 2018 Ponte Vedra Auto Show will be selected by a panel of 16 judges consisting of auto enthusiasts, collectors and experts from around the First Coast.

LARRY WEISMAN

This year's head judge, Weisman is a financial advisor and self-described car nut who also holds a Bachelor of Science in aeronautical engineering. Weisman worked on flight tests for commercial and military aircraft before becoming a financial advisor 21 years ago. Just over 10 years ago, Weisman owned an interest in an automotive performance and restoration shop in Jacksonville. He has owned over 50 cars and currently has a Grand Sport Corvette and a Mustang SVO. Weisman has been sponsoring and volunteering with the Ponte Vedra Auto Show for 14 years and is chief judge.

RICHARD NUNN

This year's master of ceremonies, Richard Nunn is a meteorologist at News4Jax. He was born and raised in South Florida and attended the University of Florida. From there, Nunn moved to Mississippi where he earned his master's degree in meteorology from Mississippi State University. His career started in Washington (state) with NBC as a chief meteorologist. His next move was to Portland, Oregon, and then after seven years, he moved back to the Sunshine State, where you can find him each weekday morning on News4Jax. Nunn is a car lover and will serve as a judge this year and the master of ceremonies for the awards presentation.

BOB BARREN

Born and raised in Jacksonville, Barren has been a member of the Florida Crown Region and Porsche Club of America (PCA) for nearly 20 years. Barren volunteers for club races at Roebling Road, Daytona and Sebring, and has participated in many PCA Concours events at the local, regional and national levels. Barren serves on the Board of Directors for Florida Crown Region and has served on the national staff of PCA as a Zone 12 representative for the state of Florida. Barren also volunteers at the Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance, volunteering as a co-chair for several years.

JIMMY BRITTS

Supporting the Navy at NAS Jacksonville is what Britts does when he is not "playing with cars." Britts is a past ARCA racecar driver, chassis builder and painter. He is the main racecar mover at the Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance, and he has been judging with the Ponte Vedra Auto Show for four years.

Duss is one of the founding members and chief judge for the Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance. He also serves as a

car judge for the Ponte Vedra Auto Show, for which he annually organizes the show's vintage motorcycle display. He has been an active motorcyclist for over 40 years, owning numerous marques and participating in several clubs. Duss is a member of the Antique Motorcycle Club of America. Automobiles as a hobby span the same period with a particular affection for Alfa Romeo. His racing enthusiasm extends from Formula 1 to sprint cars and everything in between. In addition to serving on the foundation board, Duss serves as foundation attorney.

MIKE FERRAN

Ferran has been repairing, modifying

and restoring vehicles professionally for 40 years. He is an ASE master technician and has owned Ferran Automotive since 1991. Although he currently owns a Ferrari Challenge Stradale, Ferran says he loves anything with wheels.

STEVE GIAMBRA

It all started for Giambra when he bought his first car in high school, a 1956 Corvette. 50 years later, after a long search, Giambra was able to relive the dream by purchasing another 'vette like the one he had in high school. Giambra collects American, American muscle and British sports cars and has been a judge for the past five years.


BILL HUGHES

Messer was executive director of the Petersen Automotive Museum for 12 years. Located in Los Angeles, the museum is one of the world's largest and most prestigious automotive museums. Messer, a lifelong car collector who is well connected in the collector car community, was the first to hold the museum director post. He served in the role until June 2010.

Tasker is an attorney at law specializing in criminal DUI. He owns a 5.0 Mustang, the 11th Mustang that he has owned. Tasker is a member of the First Coast Modified Mustang Club and has been judging with the Ponte Vedra Auto Show for the past six vears.

BILL HATCHETT

Hatchett is a car collector, aficionado

and car judge for the Festivals of Speed. As a son of a high-level executive at Ford, he's been around many cars, shows and racing his entire life. The first special car in his life was his dad's company car, a 1956 T-Bird. His first car in high school was a 1968 Shelby GT-500 KR. He spent many years driving a 1968 Porsche 911L at Florida Crown Region Porsche Club driving events and currently has a 1966 Ford Cortina GT, a 1967 VW Beetle and a rare turquoise 1997 BMW Z3. His wife calls him a "car magnet," and he is always on the lookout for the unusual project to keep him busy. This will be Steiger's first year serving as a Ponte Vedra Auto Show judge.

"We were lucky," Redig said about sponsoring the Auto Show. "We took over from Brumos. We thought it was a really good fit for the group."

Fields will also be bringing back its popular Porsche test drive, which gives visitors the opportunity to get behind the wheel of one of the company's luxury sports cars. (Read page 20 for more information.)

"We jumped right in with the Chamber and said we would continue the sponsorship," Redig said. "This will be our third year doing it, and we couldn't be happier. It's been a really good program.

Perhaps more importantly this year, the weather is expected to be pleasant. Last year's event, originally scheduled for Sept. 10, had to be moved to Sept. 24 because of Hurricane Irma.

"It's so nice to be able to not have to stress about a hurricane," Boudreaux

And if the weather doesn't completely cooperate, the Auto Show has that covered, too.

"Rockaway Gardens is sponsoring the hospitality tent, which will be a nice place for people to get in out of the sun and enjoy their food and just come and relax and cool off a little bit," Boudreaux said.

Boudreaux said the Ponte Vedra Auto Show is a huge deal for both the Chamber and the area.

"The Auto Show is the (Chamber's) largest fundraiser of the year and fifth largest auto show in the state," Boudreaux said. "People come from South Georgia and Hilton Head and South Florida for this. It's something that people look forward to every year. We're excited to be able to keep this show in Ponte Vedra."

It's no secret that the long-cherished seniors' programs Social Security and Medicare are on the ropes. It has been forecast for decades that these entitlements would hit the wall, as benefits were enhanced, people lived longer, and the huge baby boom generation gave birth to fewer children to take up the burden of the FICA taxes that fuel the system. Since the money that retirees paid into the plans was spent long ago, it's only current taxes that keep the checks will not be enough in just a few years. With seniors plans (plus Medicaid) taking over half of Federal spending and increasing red ink in Washington's budget, it's no surprise that push is coming to shove. 
Attendees of the Ponte Vedra Auto Show will once again have the opportunity this year to test drive a variety of Porsche models.

The Macan GTS, 911s, and 718 Cayman and Boxters will be among the cars available for the experience, which Porsche Jackson-ville General Manager Brandon Starks said is certainly unique.

the Beginning," will be available at the auto show. He will be signing copies at the event.



Fields anticipates arrival of new, exciting cars

Fields Auto Group — the presenting sponsor of the Ponte Vedra Auto Show — is looking forward to adding several new and exciting cars to its portfolio in the coming months.

Perhaps the most intriguing is the Jaguar I-Pace, the brand's first all-electric SUV. According to Garry Redig, vice president of operations for Fields in the Jacksonville market, the I-Pace can travel 240 miles per charge, and goes from 0 to 60 mph in four-and-a-half seconds. The starting range MSRP for the vehicle is \$69,500, and Fields is expecting it to be available in Jacksonville within the next few months.

"Every article written about it says it's going to give Tesla a run for its money," Redig said. "It's stunning."

On a similar note, Brandon Starks, general manager of Porsche Jacksonville, said Porsche's all-electric car will be available within the next 12 months. In addition, he said the Porsche Cayenne will soon be completely redesigned.

Another car of interest for Fields is the Mercedes-Benz UX, which is coming out in early November. Blair Sharpe, general manager of Mercedes-Benz of Jacksonville, said this car is being praised for its technology and subsequent ability to learn and adapt to the user. Sharpe noted the UX will have a Siri or Alexa-type capability that will enable users to make changes in the car by simply saying them out loud. The car will be part of Mercedes-Benz's A Class and be priced in the mid \$30,000s.

"Instead of saying, 'Hey Siri or hey Alexa,' you say, 'Hey Mercedes, can you turn the heat down?" Sharpe explained about the UX. "That in itself is a huge leap forward."

Mercedes-Benz of Jacksonville is additionally looking forward to the brand's new, redesigned G-Wagen. Sharpe said it will still have the same attributes of the original G Wagen, such as off-roading capabilities and its iconic styling, but it will be both wider and longer. Sharpe is expecting that to come out in

In addition, Redig said Fields is anticipating the arrival of Cadillac's new XT4, a smaller version of the brand's XT5 Crossover. The XT4 has a MSRP of \$35,000, which Redig noted is a price point that is very attractive to consumers, especially the younger demographic. After waiting for the XT4 for three years, Redig said the car should be available in Jacksonville in a few months.

Redig added that Lexus is coming out with a brand-new Lexus ES sedan, which has a base MSRP of \$39,500. Not to mention, Lexus is unveiling another small crossover sports utility called the Lexus UX. Redig expects that to come out in December.

1936 Chrysler C-9 Airflow Coupe takes top prize

Although she tried, not even Hurricane Irma was able to stop the 15th annual Ponte Vedra Auto Show from taking place last year in Nocatee.

Presented by Fields Auto Group and organized by the St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce, the event which was postponed from its original date due to historically inclement weather - was held Sept. 24 at Nocatee Town Center and attracted roughly 3.500 attendees.




