The St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce's Leadership St. Johns (LSJ) Class of 2018 has completed its year-long program and graduated 27 participants from all sectors of industry, commerce and public service, the most in the program's history.

The leadership development program, which was started in 2001, has over 300 alumni, including the former superintendent of schools and current Flagler College President Joseph Joyner, the current Superintendent of Schools Tim Forson, Flagler Hospital CEO Jason Barrett, local entrepreneur and St. Augustine Distillery founding partner Philip McDaniel, District 1 School Board Rep. Beverly Slough and St. Augustine City Manager John Regan.

Isabelle Renault, the Chamber's president/CEO and a graduate of Leadership St. Johns and Leadership Florida, suggested that involvement in LSJ can be a

stepping stone to participating in nonprofit and volunteer government advisory boards, as well as potential involvement in future elected office.

Florida's economy to be subject of Chamber Economic Development Breakfast

Florida's economy as profiled in the Florida Chamber's new report, "The Florida 2030 Project," will be the subject of a talk by Dr. Jerry Parrish, chief economist and director of research for the Florida Chamber of Commerce, at the St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce Economic Development Council (EDC) Quarterly Breakfast on Friday, Nov. 16 at 8 a.m. at the Renaissance World Golf Village

"Dr. Parrish will present a lively and current look at Florida's economy in this post-election discussion," said Isabelle Renault, president and CEO of the St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce. "He will also be discussing the Florida 2030 Project, a two-year research program that will stimulate strategic thinking about Florida's future and engage business and community leaders across Florida. His comments are always practical and relevant."

In his role, Parrish is responsible for conducting indepth analyses on the Florida economy and on solutions to help secure Florida's future. He previously was the chief economist and director of the Center for Competitive Florida at Florida TaxWatch. Prior to that position, he served as the associate director of the Center for Economic Forecasting & Analysis (CEFA) at Florida State University, and has many years of experience in the private sector in management roles at international manufacturing companies.

Parrish is currently an adjunct instructor in the Masters in Applied Economics Program at Florida State University. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Business and Economics from Auburn University, a Master of Business Administration from Bellarmine University, a Master of Science in Economics from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, and a Ph.D. in Economics from Auburn University. He regularly publishes research reports and articles on the Florida economy and Florida's competitiveness.





that are qualified to join is a pretty small pool of people."

Simpler asserted, however, that the nationwide challenge regarding military recruitment doesn't apply to the Florida National Guard, as there are several potential members waiting to join, receive training and take advantage of the ensuing benefits.

"Readiness also means being ready to respond to help our fellow Floridians if we have a natural disaster," he said. "We're certainly ready to do all that and while these things are challenging, there's certainly lots of reasons to be optimistic about our future."







Understanding hurricanes: St. Johns County Chamber members encouraged to be prepared, know risks

On Sept. 19, as the Carolinas began their walk down the long road to recovery following the devastation incurred by Hurricane Florence, St. Johns County Emergency Management Deputy Director Jeffrey Alexander encouraged local members of the St. Johns County Chamber of Commerce to stay vigilant.

"The tropics are quieting down after having six storms out there all at once, and we're looking like we're going to get a bit of a respite from it, but it's coming back," he warned the attendees of the Chamber's Ponte Vedra Beach Division luncheon at Sawgrass Country Club. "Don't think that we're out of the woods. because hurricane season runs all the way to the end of November.'

Alexander, who recently served as the operations and logistics chief for St. Johns County during Hurricanes Matthew and Irma, said it is imperative that residents obey mandatory evacuation orders when they are issued.

"This is really all about keeping people alive," he said. "We can't save your property, we can't save structures ... but we can save lives. Everything else we can replace or repair."

While Alexander acknowledged that evacuating can be a hassle, he urged residents to remember that they don't necessarily have to go far.

"You don't have to go thousands of miles to get away from a hurricane,

you just have to get out of the hurricane evacuation zone," he said. "Step over the line; that's all you have to do.'

Stressing the importance of being proactive, rather than reactive, Alexander also encouraged both residents and business owners to have a line of credit ready and make sure they have flood insurance.

"Folks, you live in Florida," he said. "Florida's a swamp, it's always been a swamp and it will always be a swamp. You can flood, no matter where you live."
