# Local YMCA reopens after ban on gyms, fitness centers lifted

After its closing in mid-March, the Ponte Vedra YMCA recently announced it will be reopening, beginning Monday, May 25.

The Y's decision has come after a recent announcement from Gov. Ron De-Santis regarding the reopening of gyms across the state of Florida.

According to a YMCA of Florida's First Coast news release, branches will be implementing a phased approach to "order to properly prepare our 15 branches for our nearly 48,000 members and train

more than 850 employees on new safety guidelines."

"Just like a lot of businesses, we are not going to look quite the same when we reopen," said Charlie Chacos, district executive director, Ponte Vedra YMCA. "That might be limited class sizes and doing social distancing in the building. Our lap swimming pool will look different when we open. We are looking forward to opening and welcoming our members in the Ponte Vedra community, however."

After closing due to pandemic restrictions, the Ponte Vedra YMCA stayed active and engaged despite its doors being shut. The location served as a hub for emergency and first responder childcare, provided online classes and even reached out to its 65 and up members to regularly check up on them during social isolation.

"We've been making calls to our seniors and letting them know they do have a resource and there are people thinking of them and if they need anything," Chacos said.

Due to Ponte Vedra's high senior population, the YMCA is taking extra precautions to ensure their older patrons can still enjoy the benefits of their mem-

bership while staying safe. The branch plans to update their hours of operation by allotting time for older members and vulnerable populations, as well as enforcing face masks for all staff and requiring temperatures to be monitored upon entry for both members and staff.

"We have a very large 50 and older population," Chacos said. "The YMCA is really about building community and that's what we're focused on."

The Ponte Vedra YMCA will reopen on Monday, May 25 from 7 a.m.-3 p.m. For more information visit fcymca.org/locations/ponte-vedra-ymca.

# Local senior gets surprise, COVID-19-safe birthday party on her 100th birthday

Birthday parties aren't what they used to be thanks to COIVD-19. Just because celebrations can't be traditional doesn't mean they don't happen, however. These days, they are just a little bit more cre-

When it came to long-time member of THE PLAYERS Senior Center Ollie's birthday, friends and fellow members weren't about to skip out on the celebrations, even though Ollie has had her fair share of birthday parties -100 to be exact.

"I haven't gotten to see too many people since this all happened," Ollie said. "I miss the center, but I imagine everybody does. I heard one person say, 'I would have nothing to do if it wasn't for the center. I look forward to the center like someone were to grab my hand when I were drowning."

For many seniors in Ponte Vedra, the past few months have been lonely ones. For those that live alone, social isolation can not only be mentally taxing but downright dangerous.

At THE PLAYERS Senior Center, Ollie is very popular. She attends almost every day the center is open. She misses her yoga and tai chi classes, eating lunch with her friend Richard, bingo and the occasional band that would come play music for the group. At the center, everyone knows her name and she gives dozens of

hugs a day without being worried those hugs could potentially be unsafe.

Prior to the virus, Ollie's daughter Donna spent months planning the ultimate centennial birthday bash. When the travel restrictions were instated, she realized most of her family wouldn't be able to make it. Just weeks before her mom's birthday, she reached out to the Council on Aging's Ponte Vedra senior Center coordinator to help plan a safe surprise.

So, on Friday, May 15, when Ollie saw her center friends driving up, cars decked out in birthday wishes, she was taken completely by surprise.

"I have no idea how (my daughter) did all that and planned it and never, in some way, let it out," Ollie said. "Boy, oh boy, I never knew she could keep a secret like that. I was really speechless. I think if I were a fainting person I would have fainted."

According to both Ollie and her daughter, the secret to longevity is staying positive and feeling grateful for what you

Ollie is very grateful.

"I had more than a party," she said. "I just can't find words to tell. You know how feelings are? Everybody's are different, but imagine the deepest feeling you could feel."

Being overwhelmed with love, perhaps may not be the secret to living 100 years but it may be the secret to having so many

people love you back. If positivity is the birthday cake of life, then letting yourself feel that much love would most certainly be the icing, candles, song and, well, party.

"Everybody has a day at a time," Ollie said. "Nobody has two days at once. Everything is one day so we shall see, we shall see."

# How challenging has it been for the Chamber during these past few months as COVID-19 forced businesses to shutdown and kept many residents at home?

It's been challenging, but at the same time it's offered us opportunities to be innovative. We're doing a heck of a lot more with online platforms. We're doing webinars very frequently. We're doing one once a week right now. We're able to feature what we call Chamber conversation. One of our staff will chat with a member and ask them how they're improving and how they're challenging themselves, how they are innovating their business. It's challenging when you can't do it in person. At the same time, it does put you in a situation where you have to be a little bit more creative. What are the things we can do that have value to businesses, and where can we help?

# What are some of the things you've done to help businesses during the slowdown/shutdown?

We've pushed our gift card program through our website for not just members, but people in general to shop with Chamber members. We're pushing a lot more through our website with respect to the deals that are being offered to Chamber members and the general public to shop at their places of business. While it's been a challenge, it's created some opportunities that we've taken advantage of.

# Has the pandemic changed the way we're going to do business in the future?

The way we're doing things now — the webinars are a good example — that's something we can do moving forward. When we are back to in-person style, these webinars are going to be part of our programing as we move forward. In terms of how that impacts business moving forward. I think until we get to a point where people feel generally good about going out, you're going to want to have alternatives for those folks. One of the things I can tell you we will be doing is when we go back to large, in-person events — and we plan on having those in-person events as soon as we can — but at the same time we are going to have an online component to that so if you can't participate in person, you have to be at your office, you can call in and participate virtually. You're going to see a lot of that. We're learning from this. We're learning how to be innovative from this. We're going to be smarter about these things. We're going to make it possible for people who can't get out of their business for one reason or another to participate online. That's an exciting thing.

# Will innovation prove to be an unintended consequence of this pandemic.

If we have all these restrictions on movement and all these restrictions on gatherings of 10 or more, then you have to figure out what can we do to be consistent and fill our mission while adhering to some of the guidelines? It forces you to be better. You're still living in a competitive world. It forces you to think about ways you can do something, the way you respond.



# Lightner Museum seizes downtime for renovations

#### By Daniela Toporek

During the COVID-19 shutdown, establishments have used the free time to work on cleaning, renovation and innovation, and St. Augustine's Lightner Museum is no different.

Upon entering the bright, tiled lobby, guests will notice a tall, wooden grandfather clock with detailed carvings, telling the fairytale of Dick Whittington, mayor of London three times in the 1700s.

The fairytale told his life story, but according to the museum's associate director Ray Eme, the story is completely false.

"When he [Whittington] was a peasant boy, he had a cat who escaped on a ship to Spain and found its way to the king's castle, and it killed all the rats in the castle," Eme said. "The king was so pleased he wanted to find the cat's owner and pay him enough money for him to run his campaign for mayor of London."

The 2,500-pound clock has been part of the Lightner for some time but was relocated into the lobby while the mechanics of the clock are being repaired off-site, with plans to be reinstalled in August.

Inside the check-in area, the entire first floor was renovated, from new floors to a new gift shop, with more light and space, replacing the Victorian Village.

The Lightner also renovated its Music Room and is currently in the process of assessing its mechanical instruments to be repaired and restored. A blank wall stares right across room's entrance, waiting for the right artist to showcase their talent.

"That back wall is for the mural contest. Artists have until July 15 to submit their work," said Angela deGregory, volunteer coordinator and events manager of the museum. According to deGregory, artists can submit mural concepts that reflect the history of the museum, such as the Gilded Age and/ or the history of music.

The Science and Industry room was also worked on, with Winston Churchill's taxidermized pets, a lion and an American alligator.

On the second floor, museum regulars will notice that the Stained-Glass Gallery was also replaced with American Brilliant Cut Glass, shining from one end of the room to the other, but there was one exception.

"You see how that glass isn't as vibrant as the others?" Eme noted. "That's because it's not American glass. That's Irish-cut glass. The difference is that the sand found here has lead in it, which gives it that shiny, crystal tone to it."

New to the Ballroom Gallery is the newly restored bronze statue, Winged Mercury, c. 1890. (Fun fact, the restoration cost was \$5,000), and the painting, Return of Persephone, c. 1906, donated by Jacksonville arts patron David Gonzales.

While Florida continues phase one of reopening, museums can now hold 50% capacity, and in a small town like St. Augustine, the Lightner Museum has found refreshing ideas to give guests a reason to revisit

"St. Augustine is such a small community that people forget that we have this place," deGregory said. "I only live a couple miles away from here. This is right here, where we live."



Dear Ponte Vedra Beach Neighbors, Well, did we ever have an interesting first quarter of 2020? # Spinnaker's Reach home remodel was labor of love

I have always said "The road to a beautiful home is not always a straight path," and the remodel at 740 Spinnaker's Reach was one of those winding roads.

As mentioned in the January issue of Sand Castles, Abode Interiors & JEP Construction were hired to assist with a complete remodel to include adding a third level to this existing two-story beachside condo, originally built in the 1980s in Sawgrass Beach Club. This would allow for an additional office space, a small guest room and a fourth bathroom. After reviewing a ballooning budget, we decided to create a large third-level storage space in lieu of building out the rooms. It was however designed to allow for the potential build out at a later time.

In the beginning of any project, my process starts with a vision of how the space will ultimately look when complete, to include furniture and the overall style. That may come from an image seen in a magazine or on Houzz, or even a trip to another country. Sometimes it is just a piece of art or vintage rug that may be the inspiration. These inspirations assist in every small decision along the way, which creates the overall finished space. Every detail is important!

Serendipitously, my client's and I shared the same vision! We would transform the outdated cramped spaces, open it to the beautiful ocean view and fill it with natural elements. We would create a unique space, different from other condos in the area. The initial step was to create an open living plan that would include removing a wall that blocked the ocean view. That entailed moving the electric panel and several plumbing lines in the wall ... not an easy task but we did it! This required designing a decorative application to the two chutes on either side of island that concealed the utility lines. Hundreds of detailed mitered cuts were needed to create this showpiece. It turned out better than even envisioned.

I selected a beautiful DuChateau wood flooring in an 8-inch wire brushed finish from Prosource in Jacksonville, as well as a classic honed marble for the master bathroom. One of my favorite tiles used was a handmade encaustic cement tile (used extensively in Spain) from Cletile. com installed on the guest bath floor. The Arc in Federal Blue and White is an organic pattern that could be laid in numerous ways to create different patterns. Although they have machine-made lookalike tiles in ceramic, these are each handmade with natural pigments creating a beautiful sheen that sets them above the rest! So much so, I used their Cement Radar Wool Hex on the kitchen backsplash also. The remaining tile was selected from the Tile Market of San Marco — a wonderful showroom filled with beautiful tiles and inspiration ... sometimes it is just hard to









choose there are so many options!

Crystal cabinetry was custom designed and installed by Dura throughout in ashen greys, whites and limed wood with inset doors, and matte black hardware gave the finishing touches. We replaced all the interior door and trim with a classic shaker two-panel doors and 1-by-8-inch baseboards — clean and simple lines, perfect for the relaxed style we were looking to achieve.

A new modern staircase was created with matte black iron work from Edward's Ornamental and finished with a staircase runner in a textured wool runner.

We also installed a custom barn door for the powder bath, completed perfectly with a full-length antique mirror installed by Chao Framing. This visually expands





the foyer and reflects light in an artful way.

The accent lighting was selected from arteriorshome.com, one of my favorite lighting companies, supplying innovative lighting made with organic natural materials. Lighting is such an important aspect in a space. It is not just for task and general lighting, but it's also the element that solidifies the style in the room. It incorporates the finishing details that a room needs to feel complete.

In creating a neutral space, we would bring in wall texture to add interest and act as a backdrop to the furnishings. We applied Stikwood's White Weathered Wood paneling in a herringbone pattern on the main wall in family room and created a geometric pattern in the charcoal color on the backwall of the master bedroom. This makes for a striking backdrop to the white-wash Noir Furniture in the master bedroom. It's all in the details!

A large casual sectional and chairs were covered in a beautiful thick linen in the family room and local artist Greg Morgan made an amazing custom coffee table out of a slab of red oak and white concrete. It's a room that says, "relax and enjoy."

Four Hands' Conner table was the perfect addition to the dining space. Simple, yet sophisticated, a bluestone top with black washed oak and splayed parsons style leg, leaving ample room for diners and a bit of drama. Simple white linen chairs complete the look.

This condo remodel was a labor of love, a common theme in every project I undertake. I am thankful for the opportunity to have collaborated with my client to create a home they will enjoy for years to come, "Their Happy Place!" My love of design, the awe of amazing materials available and the dedication of all my general contractors, subcontractors and artisans make for a rewarding career.

# Quarantine tips for making the most of pantry staples, seasonal veggies

Welcome to the quarantine food challenge!

Thankfully, I love to cook, but I have thought about so many of you out there who may be finding this season a bit challenging if cooking is not your thing. I want

to share two easy recipes that are not only delicious but are a great way to use some pantry staples as well as a way to make your vegetables last longer and taste absolutely delicious!

Most of us have cans of beans, soups and vegetables in our pantries, and hopefully you have one of the most common ingredients; tomato sauce or crushed tomatoes. Since most of us are having to cook more from home and getting our cooking creations fired up, this canned powerhouse could become your best food friend.

From making homemade spaghetti sauces to vegetable soups, this versatile can of tomato sauce packs a lot of punch. Below you will find an easy, delicious, homemade Rotisserie chicken enchilada recipe that will use that can of tomato sauce, as well as some common spices most of us have in our cabinet.

The other recipe I want to share is an easy way to preserve fresh bell peppers of any color or type to be used in a variety of ways later. They can be used as a side dish with any meal, on cheese and crackers, salads, top a pizza, create a pasta dish or in a sandwich; or puree in a blender to make a sauce or vinaigrette. The possibilities are not only delicious, but endless!

The Recipe below is for grilled bell peppers that are tossed in a delicious vinaigrette that can be stored in the fridge for up to two months or frozen for many months.



# CHARRED BELL PEPPERS IN HERB VINAIGRETTE

(Note: this recipe can be halved, doubled, tripled, etc.)

## 13 bell peppers (any color)

Using the grill, broiler, or gas heat, cook the peppers until soft and their skin is charred. Transfer to a bowl large enough to hold the cooked peppers and cover tightly with plastic wrap. Allow the peppers to cool in the covered container, and prepare the vinaigrette.

- 2 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoon balsamic vinegar
- 2 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 4 tablespoon olive oil
- Salt and pepper

■ 10 fresh basil leaves, other variety of fresh herbs or 1 teaspoon dried herbs,

In a bowl whisk together Dijon and vinegar until emulsified. Combine oils and add to the vinegar mixture in a steady stream while whisking to emulsify. Season with salt and pepper, then thinly slice the basil and stir into the vinaigrette.

Once the peppers have cooled, remove the stem, skin, and seeds; discard. Toss the peppers in the vinaigrette then transfer to jars, or a lidded container and ensure that the peppers are completely submerged in the vinaigrette. If the peppers are not submerged, add additional oil to completely cover the peppers and store In the fridge for later use.

You now have roasted peppers in the refrigerator to use on a whim. Serve as a side dish with any meal, cheese and crackers, salads, top a pizza, create a pasta dish or in a sandwich; or puree In a blender to make a sauce or vinaigrette. The possibilities are delicious and endless!

These chicken enchiladas are one of my client favorites as well as a huge crowd pleaser, economical and freezer friendly.

# **ROTISSERIE CHICKEN ENCHILADAS** (Serves 4-6)

\*Note: This recipe can be completely gluten free with this homemade sauce and using corn tortillas

- 1 Rotisserie chicken, deboned and shredded
- 1 4-oz package cream cheese, softened
- 1 4-oz can diced green chilis
- 8 large flour tortillas or 16 small corn tortillas
- 3 cups Mexican-blend shredded cheese
- 1 batch homemade red enchilada sauce or store bought enchilada sauce of choice (Optional: ¼ cup chopped fresh cilantro and black olive slices for garnish)

#### **Homemade Enchilada Sauce**

- 1 Tbsp olive oil
- 2 minced garlic cloves
- 2 Tbsp Chili powder



- 2 tsp Cumin
- 1 tsp Oregano
- 1 tsp Onion powder
- 2 tsp hot sauce (optional)
- ½ tsp salt
- 1 can (15 oz) tomato sauce
- ¼ cup water



# The TWA Hotel: A transformation back to the 60s

A new hotel has opened just outside of JetBlue's Terminal at JFK Airport in New York City. I got the experience to stay there for a night on my way to JetBlue's inaugural flight, and it was amazing.

Once you leave the departure area at JFK terminal 5, there are signs that guide you to the TWA hotel. That already gets my excitement going. Then I was greeted by the bright red TWA elevator.

In the area just before the skywalk to the lobby, there was an exact replica of the former CEO of TWA Jack Frye's office with a brief history of the airline. I then took a slow stroll through the lobby as it was straight out of the 1960s.

After the very futuristic automated check-in, I headed to my room. The room was modern with a well-stocked minibar that, for some reason, had an Etch-A-Sketch. The minibar was a bit expensive but there was also a true bar to prepare drinks on. All of the rooms had an old copy of LIFE magazine from the 60s, which I think is a great touch. The bed was firm, but also soft, and I got a great night's sleep on it. Other than that, it was a normal room.

In the lobby, there are two old-fashioned departure boards — one displaying random departures from New York and the other making little mosaics. The lobby is the exact same as the original terminal minus all of the asbestos. The other side of the check-in desks were made into a small food court/cafe. There is also a gift shop with TWA-branded merchandise for sale.

In front of the terminal is one of the TWA hotel's defining features, the Lockheed L-1049 nicknamed "The Connie." The Connie was transformed into a bar





with an open cockpit at the front. During
the winter seasons, there is an ice skating
rink right next to Connie with reasonable
pricing.

Elsewhere in the lobby, there is a full-service restaurant that I unfortunately never got to try out. The main attraction, however, is the rooftop pool and bar. Despite it being about 20 degrees outside, the pool was still warm and I did go swimming. The views from the pool are absolutely jaw-dropping. The pool is directly facing the back end of the JetBlue terminal with the international terminal in the background. Throughout most of the day, you can see various Emirates A380s.

Towels are provided for free.

The staff were all awesome and knew lots about the history of the building and of TWA. There also is a small display of all past TWA uniforms. Tucked away in a little nook there are some phone booths that play a recording of an old TWA advertisement.

Overall this is an awesome hotel that I think all Aviation enthusiasts should stay at for at least one night. One thing I will mention are the prices. I can understand part of the prices because I experienced the hotel as it was about half full. Even with a promotional discount, it was still more than \$100 a night for a room with





no good view. The prices for regular room range from \$160 a night for my room up to \$380 for a room with a runway view. There is also the Howard Hughes Presidential suite for \$660 a night.

In conclusion, the TWA Hotel is a wonderful experience. It is almost like staying in a museum dedicated to aviation. The staff is like tour guides who are very knowledgeable and engaging. It is also in an extremely convenient location in relation to JFK airport as it is onsite.

One of my best tricks for any layover at JFK is to go to the TWA Hotel lobby and relax there. I would definitely stay here again — 10/10!



My daughter Allison's favorite is the grilled chicken with risotto. She always substitutes the asparagus with spinach.

Realtor Kelly Whitaker orders a tray of lasagna for her family when the kids come over.

"It's so delicious," she said.

When hosting a book-signing or fundraiser at my home for a large group of people I always include Poppy's chicken piccata and I ask them to cut the chicken in smaller portions. This is a favorite of my guest and it can be ordered as a whole tray or half a tray. My grandson Scott loves Poppy's meatballs, no pasta and plain bread.

The waiters are always accommodating and if you decide to dine in early you can order the early bird specials from 3-5:30 p.m., which includes a glass of house wine.

I highly recommend Poppy's Italiana, one of Ponte Vedra's restaurant treasures!

#### **Directions for sauce:**

Heat a small saucepan to medium heat. Add olive and garlic, and stir for about 20 seconds until fragrant. Add the seasonings and hot sauce if using, and stir mixture for about 30 seconds. Add the tomato sauce and water and stir well. Bring mixture to a light simmer, cover and reduce heat to low. Let mixture simmer for 20 minutes. This makes enough for a 9x13 pan of enchiladas. I often double the recipe and freeze the rest for next time.

#### **Directions for Enchiladas:**

Debone and shred rotisserie chicken, then mix thoroughly with softened cream cheese and canned green chilies with fork. (This is easiest while chicken is warm). To assemble enchiladas, set up an assembly line including: tortillas, enchilada sauce, chicken mixture and shredded cheese. Using an oven-safe glass casserole dish, spread 2-3 Tbsp, of enchilada sauce over bottom. Lay out a tortilla, and spread approximately 3 Tbsp. of chicken and cream cheese mixture in the form of a line down upper side of tortilla. Add some shredded cheese on top, then roll up and place in dish. Repeat with remaining tortillas and ingredients. Spread remaining enchilada sauce on top of tortillas, then sprinkle on remaining shredded cheese. Bake uncovered for 20 minutes. Remove from oven and serve immediately, garnished with fresh chopped cilantro and black olives if desired. TO FREEZE: Assemble enchiladas completely, then cover with foil and freeze up to two months. Thaw completely and proceed with oven instructions.





# Reading program has paws-itive effect on area students

Speaking in public is a scary concept to many people. Imagine being a child who isn't comfortable with their reading skills being asked to read aloud in front of entire class. Or having to practice something they don't feel secure about in front of a teacher or their siblings or friends.

Wouldn't it be nice to have some completely non-judgemental listener? Someone who just enjoys the sound of your voice,but also seems fascinated with every word that comes out of your mouth? And if they're cute and cuddly, well, that's an extra bonus.

This was Laurie Wilbur's thought when she became involved with Pet Partners, the largest nonprofit that registers therapy dogs and other therapy animals through a stringent testing process. Pet Partners uses volunteers in all kinds of places like visiting hospitals and nursing homes, courtroom, airports and even prisons. But Wilbur, who has always been involved in teaching in some fashion, wanted to volunteer in a different way. When a friend introduced her to the "Read with Me" program, Wilbur found her calling. Along with her loyal companion Rosie, Wilbur began the program in the Jacksonville area, visiting Duval County schools with Ollie, and helping kids find the courage and confidence to build their reading skills.

"We work with teachers and they



give me feedback," Wilbur said of the program. "We've seen scores go up. We see them reading on their own. We start seeing them in August, and by the end of May, I can tell you how much they've improved."

The kids in the program respond really well to Rosie, a 7-year-old chocolate lab,

with a warm gaze and comforting paws. Even if they aren't sure about it initially, Rosie wins them over.

"One student was afraid at first, but she'd read, and every week, she;d get a little closer and closer [to Rosie]," Wilbur said. "By the end, she was sitting on the blanket with Rosie."

And it's not just the students who get enjoyment and confidence. Rosie has relished her role as confidence builder and skilled listener.

"She's very sweet-natured," Wilbur said of Rosie, who has been working the program for about three years, "I put her harness on and she thinks she's going to work."

When the COVID-19 crisis hit, Rosie — and Wilbur — were missing out on their regular school visits with students, but then Pet Partners came up with "We're All Ears," The program aims at helping kids keep up with their reading while not in school, by encouraging them to read to their own pets at home or even to their stuffed animals.

"The best way to do it at home is to find a nice, quiet place, and let the child be with the animal," Wilbur said. "That really does make such a difference in how they build that confidence to read aloud.

"I want it to become a forever thing for them. That they love reading."

When it comes to the "Read With

Me" program, teachers and principals select students for the program, and Rosie visits with them for around 15 minutes once a week. Wilbur can also modify the program to meet an individual student's needs.

So far, there are 10 "Read With Me" teams in Northeast Florida, but Wilbur said there is always room for more, and encourages anyone with a good-natured dog to look into it.

"We're always recruiting," Wilbur said. "It's just another way to have your dog working with the family. We all become dogs. And it keeps them involved."

# Vet technicians are like nurses for animals

Nurses are essential members of the medical community. While it is easy to think of nurses in the traditional health care setting — administering to adults and children in need — nursing disciplines extend beyond human health care. Veterinary technicians, who are petitioning to change their title to veterinary nurses, care for animals in much the same way that nurses care for people.

In 2015, the National Association of Veterinary Technicians in America initiated a conversation about changing the title of veterinary technicians to "veterinary nurse" and establishing a national licensure process similar to that used for registered nurses. As of 2018, 12 states did not specify duties that veterinary technicians can perform. Many states certify, register or license vet techs, while others do not recognize them at all. This can make it challenging for veterinary technicians, who are highly educated, credentialed and skilled, to find consistent work and earn the recognition they deserve

According to Ginny Nystrom, president of the Tennessee Veterinary Technicians Association, vet techs "dedicate themselves to assisting animals and society by providing care and service for animals, alleviating suffering, and promoting public health."

The animal welfare resource Vetstreet says vet techs play a vital role in the well-being of pets. Vet techs' responsibilities vary, and their responsibilities require dedication and compassion. Vet techs can draw blood, place catheters, assist in surgery, manage anesthesia, and administer medications.

Vet techs work in private veterinary offices, animal hospitals, zoos, and labs. According to the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics, the demand for veterinary nurses was expected to increase by 52% between the years 2010 and 2020.

Vet techs require the right educational background and credentials. Credentials vary depending on where a person lives, but generally speaking a candidate must be 18 years of age or older. One typically enrolls in an accredited veterinary technology training program recognized and approved by the American Veterinary Medical Association.

Vet techs may be required to pass an exam before they can work. On-the-job volunteer hours can additionally provide a potential vet tech with invaluable experience and also may be a component of licensure.

Veterinary techs provide care to animals much in the same way nurses tend to the human population, showcasing not only their intellect but also their compassion.

# Ponte Vedra businesses reopen, adapt to 'new norm'

After weeks of uncertainty, Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis announced early May that businesses will reopen in phases, following social distancing and CDC guidelines. And while Ponte Vedra businesses have started opening their doors, they also found new ways to adapt to the "new normal."

Although DeSantis just increased customer capacity to 50% starting May 18, the capacity limit was only 25% the week before, and local restaurants like Trasca & Co Eatery and the Aqua Grill have brainstormed concepts to attract guests without risking their safety.

"Thankfully, we didn't have to let anyone go, even during the "to-go only" phase," said Trasca & Co.'s co-owner Karina Coryell. "What we did to try and increase business was expand and work on our grab-and-go sales."

Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, Trasca already offered grab-and-go meals for busy guests, but to adapt with the lockdown, Trasca brought grab-and-go items directly to neighborhoods for residents to pick up.

"We created pop-ups in neighborhoods

and just scheduled different times," Coryell said, adding that items on the menu are also ever-changing. "No one wants to eat the same meals and people love the food offered, so all you have to do is heat and serve."

Unlike Trasca, many employees at the Aqua Grill were temporarily laid off

before the reopening of dine-ins, according to owner Cary Hart. But thanks to the implementation of deliveries and community support, Hart says the restaurant is slowly but surely getting back in action.

"We have most of our staff back for lunch and dinner and are offering delivery, which has never been done before," Hart said, excited to be back in business.

Also happy to return to work is Aqua Grill's head hostess Jamie Fowler, who was put on furlough and left unemployed since the shutdown began March 13.

Being a mother, Fowler was concerned about how she would take care of her family. She filed for unemployment and has yet to receive any assistance.

"Obviously I had to support my kids," Fowler said. "So, it was definitely worrisome. I looked for other jobs a little online but wasn't able to find anything."

When Fowler found out she was finally able to return to work, she was nervous about how the restaurant would run under the new guidelines, but it was all worth it to be reemployed and reunited with coworkers.

"They brought us all back a week early to get the restaurant clean and ready," she said. "It was just nice to be with all the employees again."

Fowler also said she missed seeing

Aqua Grill's regulars.

"Our loyal customers were still getting to-go orders before [reopening dining], but it's not the same as when they come in. It's nice to see their smiling faces again," she said.

Kendra Cantlon, co-owner of hair salon Bellezza Salon & Boutique, said the same about her loyal clients and guests.

"[It's a struggle], not being able to shake hands or hug your clients," Cantlon said, but she and her staff resist in order to reopen, stay clean and bring a safe and positive experience for those in need of a little confidence boost.

"[I had] tears of joy and was overwhelmed. But also felt confident and prepared to open in a safe and sterile environment."

Aside from keeping all tools sterile and limiting the number of appointments per day, Cantlon requires that both clients and employees wear masks to enter the hair salon and if clients don't have one, the salon will provide a mask for them.

"We also recommend bringing their own drink and reading material, and to come in by themselves, not in groups," she said.


Despite the extra steps taken, Ponte Vedra businesses are ready to persist during the pandemic and make up for lost time, financially and mentally.
