'Mank' leads the nominees in the 93rd Oscars

Ben Mankiewicz would be interested in the Oscars anyway, but this year, the film industry's top event also is very much a family matter for him.

The longtime Turner Classic Movies host is the grandson of Herman J. Mankiewicz, the co-writer (with director and title star Orson Welles) of 1941's legendary "Citizen Kane" – and the subject of "Mank," the most-nominated picture in the 93rd Academy Awards ceremony, to be staged in the coronavirus-pandemic era for the first time as ABC televises it Sunday, April 25. The show will be broadcast principally from Los Angeles' Union Station, permitting social distancing for attendees, while the traditional Oscar setting of Hollywood's Dolby Theatre still will be used for certain elements of the special.

Nominated for best picture, "Mank" is in the running for a total of 10 Oscars also including best actor (Gary Oldman), supporting actress (Amanda Seyfried) and director (David Fincher). "It's a very particular movie about the struggles of an artist who sort of hated himself and hated the business and couldn't get out of his own way," Ben Mankiewicz reflects, "but he was the guy everybody wanted to be around. He was the smartest, funniest guy in the room."

While he normally is analytical when it comes to movies, Mankiewicz notes that "what makes me emotional" about "Mank" is that his late father, veteran political insider Frank Mankiewicz, "didn't get to see this movie about his father. He would have loved it. And to me, it is precisely how he talked about his dad. Gary Oldman captured what

my image was of my grandfather perfectly, and I imagine it is locked into Gary Oldman for the rest of my life."

DISCOVER FLORIDA'S FIRST LIGHTHOUSE



Where it all began...

The original first-order Fresnel lens in the St. Augustine Lighthouse was manufactured in Paris, France. In 1986, a vandal shot the lens at the top of the tower, damaging 19 of its 370 prisms. Then President of the Junior Service League of St. Augustine, Virginia Whetstone, spearheaded a first-of-its-kind restoration project with Dan Spinella of Disney Corporation. Taking advantage of breakthroughs in laser technology, Dan measured the prisms and created the means to fabricate a new bullseye panel and 18 other prisms.

Two Coast Guardsmen, Joseph Cocking, and Nicholas Johnston, who still service the Fresnel lens today, took out the damaged parts, replaced them, and aligned the beam correctly. Initially thought of as an impossible task for a fledgling non-profit, a team effort ensured the Fresnel lens restoration, which served as a pilot project that led to other original lens restorations across the United States.



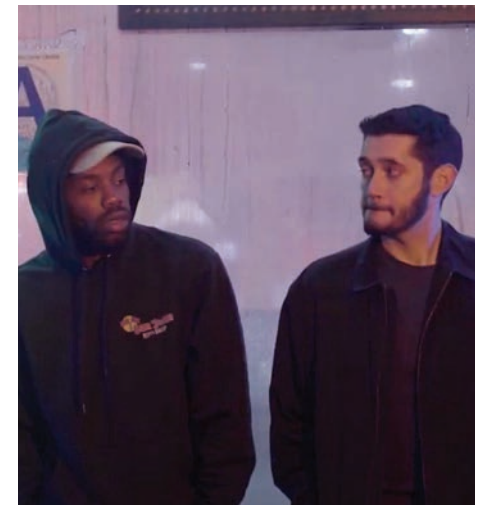

Jimmie Johnson a rookie again as he joins IndyCar



After 20 years, 686 races, 83 wins and seven championships in NASCAR's Cup series, Jimmie Johnson finds himself starting over as a 45-year-old rookie in IndyCar.

Well, not exactly starting over. After retiring from the country's top stock car racing series in 2020, the affable Californian tries his hand at open wheel, joining Chip Ganassi Racing for a limited schedule of 13 races on street and road courses. And he's found that getting used to an IndyCar entails a substantial learning curve.

In testing at several tracks over the past eight months, he's done well on straights and in tight turns but was slow on middle-speed corners. He's used to the feedback he gets from a stock car and can feel when he's about to lose control, something he has struggled to pick up from an IndyCar. But that, he feels, will come with time.

He's loved open-wheel racing since childhood and was bitten by the bug three years ago when he attended the Bahrain Formula 1 race and tried Fernando Alonso's car. Its performance blew him away and he decided he wanted more.

That led to discussions with Ganassi Racing and tests last summer on Indianapolis Motor Speedway's road course, where Johnson performed well and Ganassi saw potential. And thus a part-time IndyCar career was born.

Sunday, April 25, Johnson will be vying with the likes of James Hinchcliffe, Takuma Sato, Josef Newgarden and Ryan Hunter-Reay on a 14-turn, 1.8-mile downtown waterfront street course in the Firestone Grand Prix of St. Petersburg, which airs on NBC from the Gulf Coast Florida city.

It's a better class of 'Worst Cooks in America' as Food Network series returns

Newbie co-hosts on Food Network's "Worst Cooks in America" are often shocked by the ineptitude of its contestants. After all, it takes a special kind of incompetence to not know how to boil water or operate a can opener.

Returning host Anne Burrell finds the reactions entertaining. This season, Michael Symon was the unsuspecting party.

"It's one of my favorite things ever on the first day," Burrell explains, "when I have a new co-host and they see just how bad these people really are, and they look at me and they're like, 'Oh my God! Is this a joke?' And I'm like, 'No, this is the real deal.' And it just cracks me up every time because ... they are just absolutely shocked and they're like, 'What did I get in for?' Like they think that they're mentally prepared for it and we try to tell them and it really is quite amazing."

Premiering Sunday, April 25 (and also streaming on discovery+), the new six-episode "Worst Cooks" season titled "Best of the Worst" brings back fan favorites from seasons past to try again at transforming from kitchen disasters to something resembling a culinary master. Burrell and Symon ("Burgers, Brew and 'Que") lead red and blue

teams through a boot camp designed to improve contestants' skills, then put them through a series of challenges that showcase what they've learned. The winner gets a \$25,000 grand prize.

Because this is not their first time, the would-be chefs are tasked with challenges that are on a slightly higher level than they would be for the rookies. Here, they include a Vegas-themed game show, a camp cookout where stoves and ovens are off limits and a "tour de petit four" dessert relay race.

And there is plenty of pressure as Burrell and Symon will show their recruits a technique such as how to slice an onion, once, and then require them to repeat it on camera during competition – with all the distractions that would imply. While some fail, others catch on and still others wind up embracing skills that serve them elsewhere in life.

"Especially during the pandemic when everyone was on lockdown," Burrell notes, "I heard from a lot of past recruits saying, 'Oh my gosh! Thank God for "Worst Cooks," because now during the pandemic I can actually cook at home. I don't know what I would have done if I hadn't had that.'"

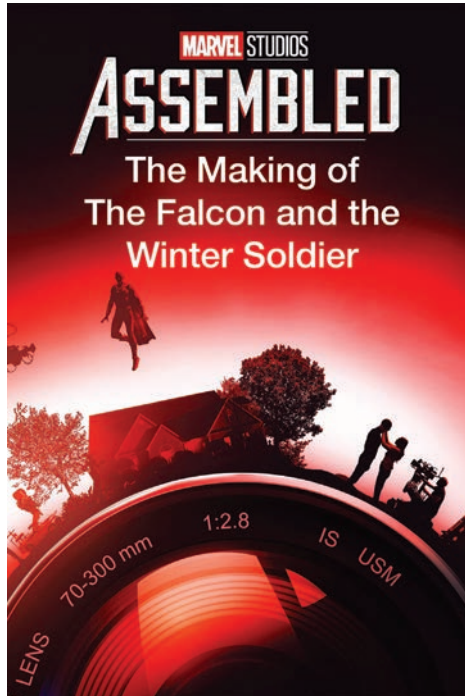
“Adventures in Wonderland” (April 30)

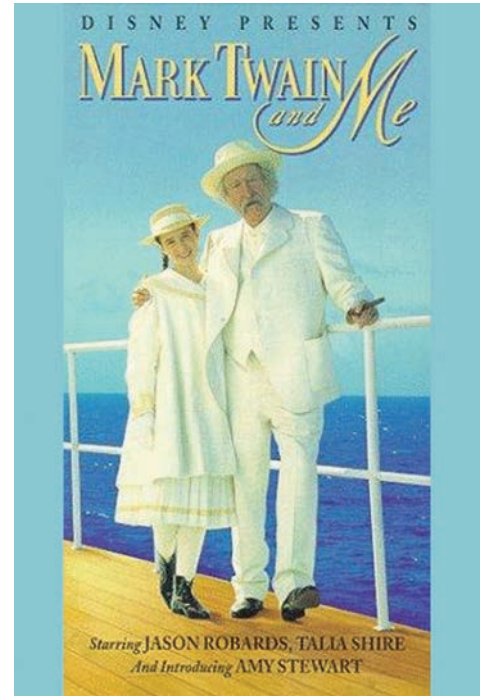
“Oklahoma!” (April 30)

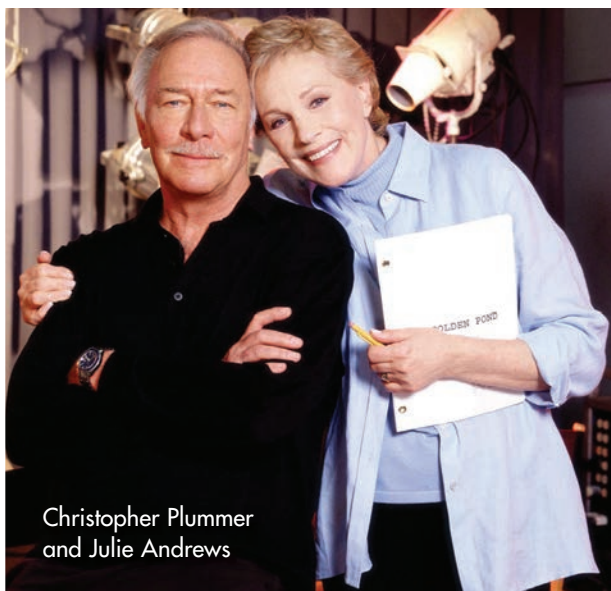
