HIGHLIGHTS: The Tigers were a late addition to the Willard Tournament and ended up picking up two wins there over Camdenton and Branson.
OUTLOOK: Smith-Cotton had to adjust to a more challenging CMAC slate in 2020-21, and that came after a quarantine period that kept the Tigers out of action for nearly a month. After averaging 49.1 points, S-C will have to find enough production to try and increase that while replacing what came from the graduated Matt Thompson (21 ppg) and Dane Foster (13 ppg). James Bennett, Carson Hunolt and Sam Cash are among the returners who received playing time last winter.

HEAD COACH: Kevin Carr

2020-21 RECORD: 1-18

HIGHLIGHTS: Up against the prospect of a winless season, S-C won its final regular season game at Northeast, 65-25.

OUTLOOK: The first season in the CMAC was something of a challenge for the Lady Tigers, who couldn't find a victory in those six games. They allowed an average of 58.7 points per game, but it's the 27.3 points averaged offensively that needs improvement equally, if not more. First-year head coach Kevin Carr, previously boys basketball head coach at Clinton, was hired for the outgoing Jesse Arnold. "After (Carr's) first meeting with the girls, there was an immediate boost to the morale of the basketball girls, which was pretty cool to see," Smith-Cotton AD Rob Davis told the Democrat following Carr's hiring. Left to fill the shoes of the graduated Alexis Spencer and Caroline Metz are senior forward Bailey Brown (Rockhurst), alongside juniors Rilee Jackson and Hayleigh Snyder.

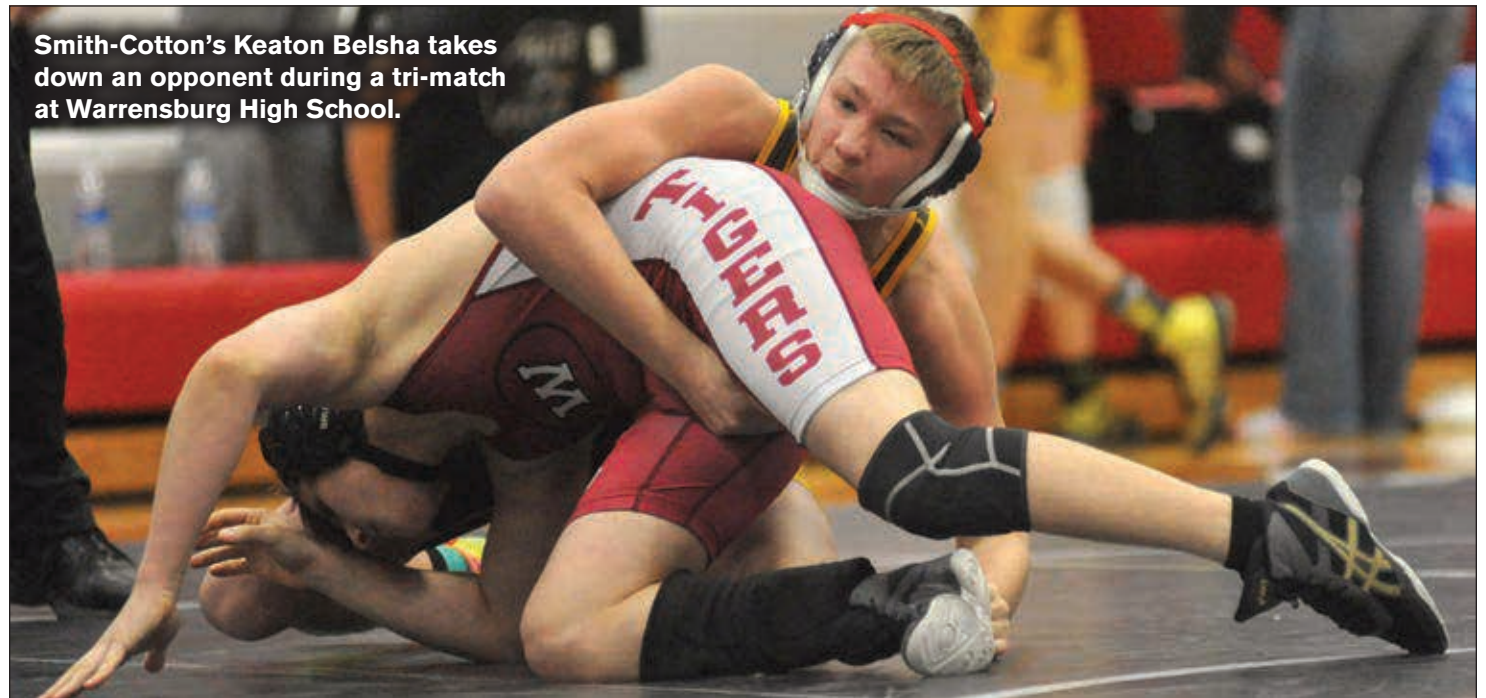

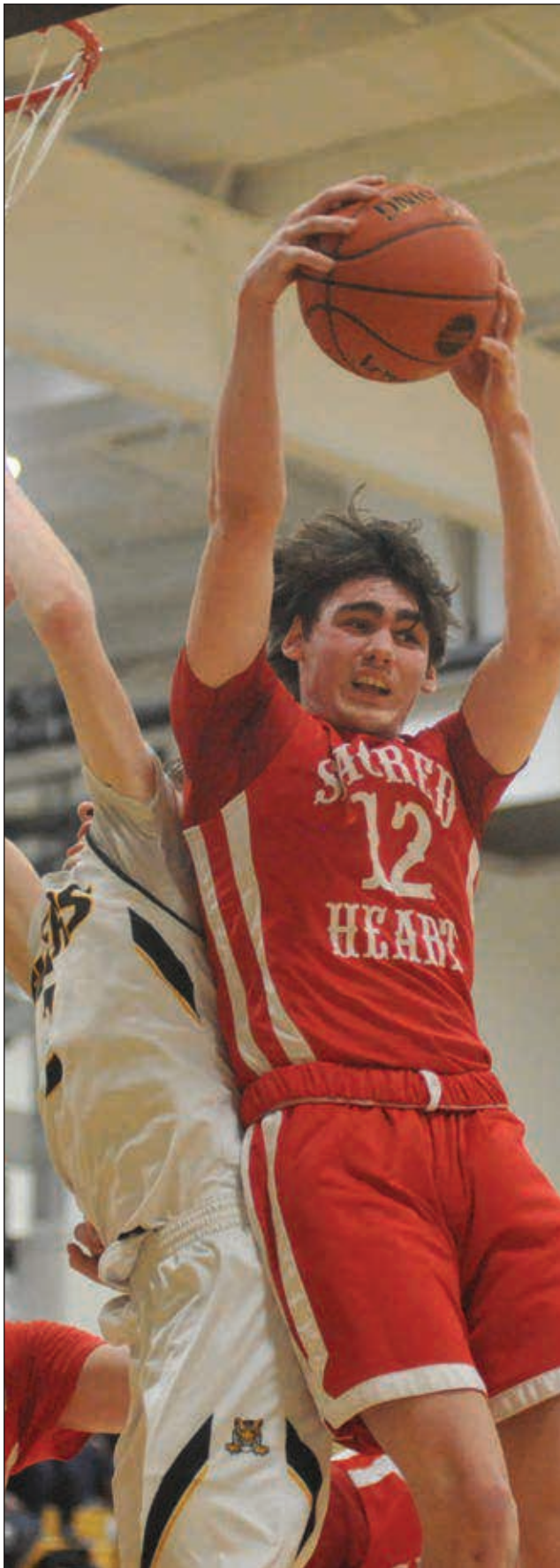
