GROWTH & EXPANSION

Warrensburg is a thriving community of just under 20,000 residents. As the regional hub of a six-county area and home to the University of Central Missouri and nearby Whiteman Air Force Base, Warrensburg is well-positioned for continued economic growth. Warrensburg's centralized location, its affordable business climate and its sophisticated small-town appeal have provided tremendous growth momentum recently.

From small friendly boutiques to large retail stores and unique antique shops, there is something for everyone to enjoy. The Warrensburg business community offers more than 70 restaurants/bars and approximately 100 retailers. Recent additions of new companies such as Marshalls, Hy-Vee, Starbucks, Casey's General Stores, Fazoli's, Factory Connection, Culver's Restaurant, and Firehouse Subs show that businesses and residents alike recognize the wonderful assets Warrensburg has to offer.

This recent growth has also had a positive impact on employment and the number of jobs available in the Warrensburg area, as the heartland work ethic and community pride make it a great place to do business. This has helped to create a diversified job base that provides the area with a secure and growing economy. In the public sector, major employers include nearby Whiteman Air Force Base with more than 8,200 civilian and uniformed personnel on its \$381 million-dollar payroll and the University of Central Missouri with more than 1,400 faculty and staff members. Private corporations have also contributed to

the area's high employment rate and bright economic outlook. Recently, after fierce competition, Warrensburg was selected for the site of the 23rd Dollar Tree Distribution Center, a \$110 million dollar project, which services more than 850 stores across an 11-state region. The company, which has been operational since July 2018, employs approximately 390 at its 1 million-square-foot facility in eastern Warrensburg.

When not working, residents enjoy a high quality of life including access to quality education, recreation, shopping, appreciating home values and a low cost of living. Warrensburg boasts the best of rural life: an educated available labor pool, a world-class university, a burgeoning downtown and an engaged community that works hard every day to improve the place they call home. Warrensburg's amenities rival larger cities but with a mid-America, small-town feel. First-rate health care, first-rate infrastructure, and plenty of entertainment and leisure activities allow for all community members to enjoy and thrive in Warrensburg.

The economic development partners of the City of Warrensburg, Warrensburg Main Street, the Greater Warrensburg Area Chamber of Commerce, and the Johnson County Economic Development Corporation dedicate their efforts to preparing and growing the Warrensburg community.

The Warrensburg Chamber's focus is on business retention and expansion. It provides many services to new and existing businesses in the Warrensburg area. These services include but are not limited to providing

networking opportunities for community business members and providing information on the area to individuals and companies interested in relocating or locating businesses in the Warrensburg area.





AGRICULTURE

WARRENSBURG: JUST THE FACTS

No matter where your travel plans take you, Warrensburg, Missouri, is on the way.

Located in the center of the country's heartland, Warrensburg is an hour's drive from Kansas City, four hours from St. Louis, and three hours from Branson. Warrensburg residents are in the enviable position of being able to enjoy the attractions of metropolitan areas and the advantages of small-town life. Unlike purely suburban areas, Warrensburg is a self-contained city with a vibrant employment base, active cultural scene, and many civic events and activities. Warrensburg serves as the county seat of Johnson County.

Established in 1855, Warrensburg is a third-class city, with a council-manager form of government adopted in 1957. Its five council members are elected at large and one council member is selected by the council to serve as mayor.

The City of Warrensburg provides police, fire, street maintenance, sewer, animal control, building inspection, and planning and zoning services within the city limits. Additionally, it provides animal shelter services to unincorporated Johnson County and maintains the Sunset Hill Cemetery. Warrensburg is home to nine beautiful parks covering more than 400 acres, including three award-winning parks – Cave Hollow, Grover Memorial and Shepard Park – miles of hiking trails, a skate park, dog park, eight tennis courts, six playgrounds, seven ballfields, two soccer fields, and Nassif Aquatic Center.

The Warrensburg Community Center features a full-size gymnasium with six basketball goals, a walking track, the Indoor Aquatic Facility, seven meeting rooms, and the award-winning WCC Fitness Center. The Community Center also provides space for the Senior Center that operates a weekday lunch and home delivery program.

The City operates with approximately 240 full-time, part-time, and seasonal employees.

City Government

The City of Warrensburg has a city council-manager form of government in which an elected city council serves as the city's primary legislative body and appoints a chief executive officer, called a city manager, to oversee day-to-day municipal operations, to draft a budget, and to implement and enforce the council's policy and legislative initiatives.

City council members serve staggered three-year terms with elections held annually in April. Council members may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms before they are term-limited, but they may sit out for a term and run again.

The council is currently composed of Mayor Scott Holmberg (term expires 2022), Chairman Pro Tem Jim Kushner (2023), and council members Casey Lund (2023), Nolan Brooks (2022) and Tarl Bentley (2024).

The city's administrative offices operate out of City Hall at 102 S. Holden St. on the city campus that includes the Municipal Building across the street and Fire Station 1 and the Police Department buildings west of City Hall.

City Manager Danielle Dulin oversees the city's daily operations. Department heads, including the police and fire chiefs, human resources, community development, planning, finance, and public works directors, answer to Dulin.

The city also has numerous boards and commissions composed of volunteer members who report to the council.

Members of the public may attend the city council meetings, generally hosted at 7 p.m. on the second and fourth Mondays of every month at the Warrensburg Municipal Center.

COUNTY GOVERNMENT

Johnson County government consists of 15 elected officials who operate independently in carrying out the day-to-day duties of their offices.

Most elected officeholders serve four-year terms.

The Johnson County Courthouse, 300 N. Holden St., Warrensburg, is the hub of most of the governmental activity, housing many county offices. The judiciary and law enforcement branches operate from the Johnson County Justice Center, 101 W. Market St., Warrensburg, and the Johnson County Sheriff's Office and Jail, 278 SW 872nd Road, between Holden and Centerview. Additionally, the Assessor's and Collector's offices operate out of the County Annex, 1310 S. Maguire St., Warrensburg.

Courthouse, Annex and Justice Center hours of operation are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30

p.m. Monday through Friday. The county's website is www.jococourthouse.com.

Johnson County Commission

The commission, the administrative arm of the county, is composed of a presiding commissioner, who is elected countywide, and one commissioner each from the eastern and western districts. Current officials are Presiding Commissioner Densil Allen, Western Commissioner Charles Kavanaugh, and Eastern Commissioner John Marr.

Commissioners establish county policy. They make decisions involving county property; develop, adopt and enforce the county budget; develop ordinances for the public health, safety and welfare; supervise the building and maintaining of roads and bridges; and other

administrative functions, such as making appointments to county boards.

Commissioners generally meet in the commission chambers at the courthouse from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. The phone number is 660-747-2112.

JCCHS Home Health promotes independence and recovery in the home setting through nursing, therapy and social services. Voted "Best in the Burg" for home health services, JCCHS offers specialized care to those recovering from surgery or who have conditions requiring regular medical care in the comfort of home.

WIC services provide essential nutritional needs and education. This includes supplemental food, health care referrals, nutrition education, and breastfeeding promotion and support to eligible pregnant women, new mothers, breastfeeding and postpartum women, infants, and children up to age five. Fathers, grandparents, guardians, and foster parents may also apply for benefits for children living in their household.

Warrensburg R-VI School District

The Warrensburg School District, founded in 1866, is located in Johnson County and is just an hour's drive from Kansas City, Missouri. The population within the District is 26,794. The District employs 532 staff members who serve 3,383 PreK-12th grade students on eight campuses. Over 58% of the district's teachers hold advanced degrees, and they average 12.5 years of classroom experience. The average student-to-teacher ratio is 13 to 1, the student-to-classroom teacher ratio is 17 to 1, and the Warrensburg District is fully accredited by the State Board of Education.

With aspiring Purple Star Schools, the District recognizes the significance of supporting our military families and students and has a dedicated liaison located in each school. These liaisons are specifically trained to support our families and the issues they face, such as relocation, deployment, loss, academic planning, and eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.

Warrensburg is a 1-to-1 technology school district with students assigned a device to assist with their learning. Students in PreK-fourth receive an iPad, and students in grades fifth-12th receive a laptop. The District uses the learning platform of SeeSaw at the elementary level and Canvas at the secondary level. Technology Specialists are available at each building to assist students and teachers with issues. The District also has two district-wide Technology Integration Specialists along with Instructional Coaches at each building to work specifically with staff to enhance instruction and student learning.

The District has a preschool program, early childhood special education, full-day kindergarten, and before and after school child care. Each elementary school has a media center and offers art, music, and physical education by fully certified staff members and services for students with special needs. Staff supporting the education process in each building include a principal, assistant principal, school nurse, social worker, counselor, and Title teachers at each elementary. As students move to the middle school level, opportunities to participate in band, sports activities, and numerous after-school clubs abound.

High school students can take advantage of the A+ program opportunities, dual credit, and advanced placement classes in various subjects, along with courses in robotics, biomedicine, and broadcasting. Students can participate in the University of Central Missouri Innovation Track, which allows them to earn two semesters of college credit by the time they graduate high school. Additional college credit is also offered through other regional institutions as well.

The district's Service Learning Program, which combines an academic classroom

These partnerships and the patron support of the school district make Warrensburg a great place to raise a family.



WHITEMAN AIR FORCE BASE

Sixty miles southeast of Kansas City, nestled among the wooded, rolling hills of west-central Missouri, two miles south of Knob Noster, is the bustling community of Whiteman Air Force Base. Whiteman is the home of the 509th Bomb Wing, which is proud to serve as the host unit for the base. Other associated units at Whiteman include the Air Force Reserve's 442nd Fighter Wing, the Missouri Army National Guard's 1-135th Aviation Battalion and the Missouri Air National Guard's 131st Bomb Wing.

Mission

The mission statement of the 509th Bomb Wing is "Team Whiteman provides Strategic Deterrence, Global Power, and Combat Support to Combatant and Joint Force Commanders...Anytime, Anywhere." Every day, members of Team Whiteman operate, maintain and support America's premier stealth aircraft and other important assets, providing national leaders with truly unmatched long-range strike and nuclear deterrence capabilities.

Primary Weapon Systems

The 509th Bomb Wing is responsible for supporting America's strategic deterrence and global power team by operating, maintaining and supporting a B-2 combat force capable of delivering rapid, decisive and precise airpower anytime and anywhere. It brings massive firepower to bear, in a short time, anywhere on the globe through previously impenetrable defenses. Assigned aircraft at Whiteman include the B-2, T-38 Talon trainer aircraft, A-10 Thunderbolt II and AH-64D Apache Longbow helicopter.

B-2 Stealth Bomber

The B-2 Stealth Bomber is a multi-role bomber capable of delivering both conventional and nuclear munitions. Possessing an unrefueled range of approximately 6,000 nautical miles and the ability to penetrate deep into enemy airspace undetected and unassisted, the B-2 can place at risk any fixed or movable target and protect the aircraft and crew from hostilities while providing them with the necessary tools to complete their mission and return safely home. Once deployed, the B-2 renders enemy air defenses ineffective and serves as a deterrent to hostilities and a preserver of peace.

The effectiveness of the B-2 was first proven in Operation Allied Force in 1999, when, during its first operations in combat, it destroyed 33% of all Serbian targets in the first eight weeks by flying nonstop from Missouri to Kosovo and back. The aircraft was also called into combat service in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in 2001, Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2003 and most recently Operation Odyssey Dawn in 2011, when

three B-2s flying a single mission destroyed the entirety of the Libyan air force while it was still on the ground.

A-10 Thunderbolt II

The A-10 Thunderbolt II is a single-seat fighter jet designed to provide close air support for ground forces by attacking tanks and other armored vehicles. The A-10 was designed around the GAU-8 Avenger, a heavy rotary cannon that forms the aircraft's primary armament. The cannon is capable of firing 3,900 rounds per minute. The A-10's hull incorporates more than 1,200 pounds of armor and was designed with survivability as a priority, with protective measures in place which enable the aircraft to continue flying even after taking significant damage. The A-10 can also employ a wide variety of conventional munitions, including general-purpose bombs, cluster bombs, laser-guided bombs, joint direct attack munitions (JDAM) and AGM-65 Maverick and AIM-9 Sidewinder missiles. The 442d has been involved in the Berlin Crisis, the Cold War and Operation Desert Storm, and Operations Deny Flight, Southern Watch, Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom.

AH-64D Apache Longbow

The AH-64 Apache is the Army's heavy division/corps attack helicopter. The Apache conducts rear, close and shaping missions including deep precision strikes. It also conducts distributed operations, precision strikes against re-locatable targets, and provides armed reconnaissance when required in day, night, obscured battlefield and adverse weather conditions. The combination of the radar, advanced navigation and avionics suite of

the aircraft provide increased situational awareness, lethality and survivability.

Air National Guard's 131st Bomb Wing

In 2008, Whiteman AFB welcomed the Missouri Air National Guard's 131st Bomb Wing into its midst as an associate B-2 unit. In fact, Whiteman Air Force Base is a model for the Air Force when it comes to "Total Force Integration," or TFI. Every day, Missouri's citizen-airmen work alongside active-duty personnel to support, maintain and fly the nation's most advanced bomber.

Air Force Reserve's 442nd Fighter Wing

The 442d Fighter Wing is composed of nearly 1,200 members at Whiteman and one geographically separated unit; the 476th Fighter Group, Moody Air Force Base, Ga. The wing is responsible for the combat readiness of 27 A-10 Thunderbolt II aircraft – all the A-10s in the Air Force Reserve. The 442d moved to Whiteman from Richards-Gebaur Air Force Base, Kansas City, Mo., in June 1994.

Army National Guard's 1-135th Attack Reconnaissance Battalion

The 1-135th Attack Aviation Battalion's mission is to conduct attack, reconnaissance and security operations that complement other maneuver forces. They control the AH-64D Apache Longbow helicopters at Whiteman. The National Guard is the only component of the armed forces that has both federal and state missions. The Missouri National Guard's federal mission is to provide federal support when called upon by

the president – this could be for overseas contingency operations or federal emergencies like Hurricane Katrina. Their state mission is to support the governor of Missouri in times of state crisis.

Base History

Whiteman has a history dating back to the years during World War II. First, the base is named in honor of 2nd Lt. George A. Whiteman, a Sedalia native who was one of the first American airmen killed in combat during World War II, when his P-40 fighter, the "Lucky Me," was shot down during the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor. In October 1955, members of the wing saw the base name change to Whiteman AFB, in honor of 2nd Lt. Whiteman.

Second, U.S. Army Air Corps officials selected the current site of the base to be the home of Sedalia Army Air Field in 1942. The base was one of eight sites dedicated to training glider pilots (specifically, those flying the Waco CG-4A) for combat missions performed by Troop Carrier Command. For a brief time following the end of World War II, the airfield remained in service as an operational location for Army Air Force C-46 and C-47 transports. In December 1947, the base was placed on inactive status and the

name changed in June 1948 to Sedalia Air Force Auxiliary Field.

After initially being considered as a possible site for the Air Force Academy, in August 1951, Strategic Air Command selected the base to be the site of one of its new bombardment wings. The base was re-designated Sedalia Air Force Base, and in October 1952, SAC activated the 340th Bombardment Wing with both B-47 Stratojet bombers and KC-97 Stratotanker air refueling aircraft assigned.

As B-47s were phased out of the U.S. Air Force in the early 1960s, Whiteman AFB's mission shifted from aircraft to the Minuteman intercontinental ballistic missile. In June 1961, officials selected the base to become the command's fourth Minuteman missile wing, the 351st Strategic Missile Wing. The 340th was inactivated in September 1963, and the missile wing went on full operational alert in June 1964.

In the late 1980s, the 351st fielded the first female Minuteman missile crew, the first male and female Minuteman crew, and the first squadron commander to pull alert in the Minuteman system.

HISTORY & HERITAGE

Warrensburg's exciting future remains anchored to its colorful western frontier past. The town's history dates to 1833 when Martin Warren, American Revolutionary War soldier, and blacksmith arrived from Kentucky and settled along the Osage Indian Trail at College and Gay streets.

In 1834, the County of Johnson was designated, and the town of Columbus was the center of county government until 1836. In 1838, a group of early Missouri leaders including Daniel Morgan Boone, son of Daniel Boone, chose the site for the county courthouse in the growing community that was to become the City of Warrensburg. The county court commissioned the building of the courthouse in that same year, and it took four years to complete. Incorporation as a city came in 1855, and the railroad arrived July 4, 1864, after it had stopped at Sedalia during the Civil War. A thriving new commercial district sprouted along the tracks, five blocks southeast of the original town (or town square), and nearby sandstone quarries helped spur growth.

The Barlow & Sanderson Overland Mail company started here. Established by Vermont men Jared L. Sanderson and Bradley Barlow during the Civil War, the Barlow-Sanderson Overland Mail Company first carried the mail and operated a stage line

between Sedalia and Warrensburg, Missouri. By 1863, was also operating a line from Kansas City, Missouri, to Fort Scott, Kansas. In 1866, they began to expand westward and transferred their headquarters from Kansas City to Junction City, Colorado. By 1867, the two entrepreneurs had established a route from Missouri to California over the Santa Fe Trail and changed the name to the Barlow and Sanderson Company.

One of the city parks, located in the historic area, has been restored and is today named Blind Boone Park. The completed restoration includes a gazebo for public musical events, a picnic area, and a statue of Blind Boone. John William "Blind" Boone (May 17, 1864 – Oct. 4, 1927) was a highly successful American pianist and composer of ragtime music, giving over 7,200 concerts in North America. The JCHS is also hoping to restore the Old Davis Store, established in 1895, and is located across the street from the Old Courthouse and the only historic commercial building left in the area.

Old Drum, a hound dog, was shot dead in 1869 by Samuel "Dick" Ferguson, nephew and ward of Leonidas Hornsby, an irate neighbor who thought Drum had been killing his sheep and is one of the most celebrated figures from Warrens-

burg's past. When U.S. Senator-to-be George Graham Vest delivered his eulogy to the dog in 1870 in a Johnson County courtroom, he had no idea his words would make him famous. His words, coining the phrase "Man's best friend is his dog," quickly won him fame across Missouri and beyond. Vest made the speech while arguing in court on behalf of Charles Burden, whose favorite dog was shot by the ward of Leonidas Hornsby. Burden sued and the case eventually wound up in the Missouri Supreme Court where the plaintiff was awarded \$50.

The trial advanced Vest's political career, and in 1958 his Tribute to a Dog was cast in bronze beneath the statue of Old Drum on the courthouse lawn. Vest's eulogy has won world fame and has been cited as one of the greatest speeches given during the 19th-century. The story of Old Drum is known and loved the world over.

Preserving our past and sharing this for our community is a prime objective for the volunteer-based Johnson County Missouri Historical Society and sister organization, The West Central Missouri Genealogical Society, both supported by the generosity of donors and its members. PLACES OF WORSHIP

A Volunteer Chaplain program works at Western Missouri Medical Center as part of the association's activities. Air Force chaplains help serve the ministerial needs of Whiteman Air Force Base, rounding out the ministries available to this community.

"Gentlemen of the jury: The best friend a man has in this world may turn against him and become his enemy. His son or daughter that he has reared with loving care may prove ungrateful. Those who are nearest and dearest to us, those whom we trust with our happiness and our good name, may become traitors to their faith.

The money that a man has, he may lose. It flies away from him, perhaps when he needs it the most. A man's reputation may be sacrificed in a moment of ill considered action. The people who are prone to fall on their knees to do us honor when success is with us may be the first to throw the stone of malice when failure settles its cloud upon our heads.

The one absolutely unselfish friend that a man can have in this selfish world, the one that never deserts him, and the one that never proves ungrateful or treacherous, is his dog."

"Gentlemen of the jury: A man's dog stands by him in prosperity and in poverty, in health and in sickness. He will sleep on the cold

ground, when the wintry winds blow and the snow drives fiercely, if only he may be near his master's side. He will kiss the hand that has no food to offer, he will lick the wounds and sores that come in encounters with the roughness of the world. He guards the sleep of his pauper master as if he were a prince.

When all other friends desert, he remains. When riches take wings and reputation falls to pieces, he is as constant in his love as the sun in its journey through the heavens.

If fortune drives the master forth an outcast in the world, friendless and homeless, the faithful dog asks no higher privilege than that of accompanying him to guard against danger, to fight against his enemies, and when the last scene of all comes, and death takes the master in its embrace and his body is laid away in the cold ground, no matter if all other friends pursue their way, there by his grave-side will the noble dog be found, his head between his paws, his eyes sad but open in alert watchfulness, faithful and true even to death."

ENTERTAINMENT AND RECREATION

The richness of a community can be measured by the quality of its cultural activities and resources. Warrensburg has a great variety of assets that make it a wonderful place to visit and live.

Community Events

The Warrensburg community sponsors several popular events including:

- The Wings Over Whiteman Air Show is hosted by Whiteman Air Force Base. This summertime biennial favorite show routinely attracts more than 50,000 visitors to the Warrensburg area.
- The Johnson County Fair held in July and the Johnson County Rodeo in September are annual events led by the Johnson County Fair Association to showcase the local agricultural industry and 4-H clubs.
- The University of Central Missouri's Homecoming parade and football game welcomes thousands of alumni and their families to our community.
- The first weekend in September, downtown Warrensburg hosts "Burg Fest," a family-friendly, fun two-day event for the community and region with music, food, and children's activities.

Other events include the Old Drum Day Festival; the university's Family Weekend; Show Me Justice Film Festival; seasonal home, art and craft shows; annual Dickens Christmas holiday event; and University of Central Missouri, Warrensburg Main Street and Warrensburg Parks and Recreation special events throughout the year.

Indoor Fun

The Warrensburg Community Center (WCC) at 445 E. Gay St. features an indoor aquatic center with a full-size lap and leisure pool, a hot tub, and a zero-depth entry splash pool with a mushroom fountain and two slides, a Fitness Center with a walking track and exercise rooms, full-size basketball/volleyball gymnasium, arts and crafts room, six meeting rooms, and kitchen facilities. The WCC can accommodate meetings, special family events and programs of all shapes and sizes, from a few up to 200 people. The separate ABC Building with full kitchen can seat up to 120. The Warrensburg Senior Center is also located in the WCC.

Warrensburg Parks and Recreation prides itself on the variety of events, programs, fitness classes and sports activities it offers to the young and the young at heart. The Warrensburg Branch of Trails

Regional Library offers a full slate of programs including children's story hours, downloadable e-books and reader assistance. The eight libraries located within the Johnson and Lafayette County district maintain more than 100,000 volumes, and the materials available include books, periodicals, and audio/visual media. The Warrensburg Branch is located at 432 N. Holden in downtown Warrensburg.

The Johnson County Missouri Historical Complex on the west side of town off Main Street is home to several unique structures. The historic 1838 courthouse is one of the few existing examples of Federal-style architecture west of the Mississippi River. This stucco-covered two-story brick building was restored to its former beauty during the early 1960s. The courthouse has been the scene of a pre-civil war murder, a daring raid to save the county records from being captured by Confederates during the Civil War, and the Old Drum Trial in 1870. The defense's closing argument was a moving speech about the dedication and loyalty of dogs and is said to be the modern origin of the phrase, "A man's best friend is the dog."

Other buildings on the property include the **Mary Miller Smiser Heritage Library**, holding a collection of materials concerning county history, family genealogy, and newspapers. **The Zinn and Leland Culp Building** holds farm machinery and household artifacts illustrating the agricultural roots of the area. **The Culp Building** is available to rent for meetings. **The Elm one-room schoolhouse** built in 1911 was relocated to the Historical Society grounds. The library is open from 1 to 4 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, or by appointment. Please schedule your visit or group tours in advance at 660-747-6480 or curator@jocomohistory.org. The University of Central Missouri Archives & University Museum houses a variety of exhibits focusing on the history of the university and local natural history. The university's Gallery of Art & Design provides arts programming emphasizing cultural and artistic diversity through a series of exhibitions, lectures, and workshops. The gallery hosts Missouri-based, national, and international artists and designers, as well as exhibiting UCM student and faculty work.

Outdoor Fun

The Warrensburg Parks and Recreation (WPR) system consists of 12 parks, 402 acres, hiking trails, skate park,

eight tennis courts, seven playgrounds, Lions Lake, seven ball fields, dog park, seven soccer fields, and the Nassif Aquatic Center, WPR's outdoor aquatic facility. For more information, contact WPR at

The beautiful Blind Boone Park, a tribute to renowned jazz pianist and composer John William "Blind" Boone, is in the city's historic area. It features a 20-foot gazebo with electricity, a life-size steel and bronze sculpture depicting Boone, a 13-foot-tall wind harp, plants native to our area, plus a sensory garden for the visually impaired. Other amenities include a reflexology walkway; roped pathways; type, Braille and audio information signs; ADA-approved bathrooms; wheelchair-accessible picnic tables; and a shuffleboard court. J.W. "Blind" Boone was a beloved member of our community who, blind and of multi-ethnic heritage, succeeded in working past many physical, cultural, and economic limitations to become a famous concert pianist.

Throughout Warrensburg and on the University of Central Missouri campus, you will find softball diamonds, tennis courts, golf courses, volleyball courts, basketball courts, racquetball, and handball facilities, walking areas and swimming pools.

Warrensburg is home to two 18-hole golf courses within the city limits and one near Whiteman Air Force Base. Mules National Golf Club, home of **Keth Memorial Golf Course**, is owned and operated by the University of Central Missouri. This public, full-service, award-winning 18-hole facility is equipped with a restaurant and pro shop. **The Hidden Pines Country Club** is a public club with an 18-hole course. The club offers a restaurant, pro shop, pool, banquet facilities and a bar. **The Royal Oaks Golf Course** offers a challenging 18-hole beautiful course. The public course offers a pro shop and snack bar on-site.

Knob Noster State Park is located 11 miles east of Warrensburg near Whiteman AFB and Knob Noster. The Park encompasses more than 3,500 acres and offers fishing, camping, covered pavilions, picnic areas, an equestrian trail and camp, and restroom facilities. The Park has a nature center with exhibits, several small lakes, small streams, and many trails for exploring. Several WPA-era buildings are still in use.
