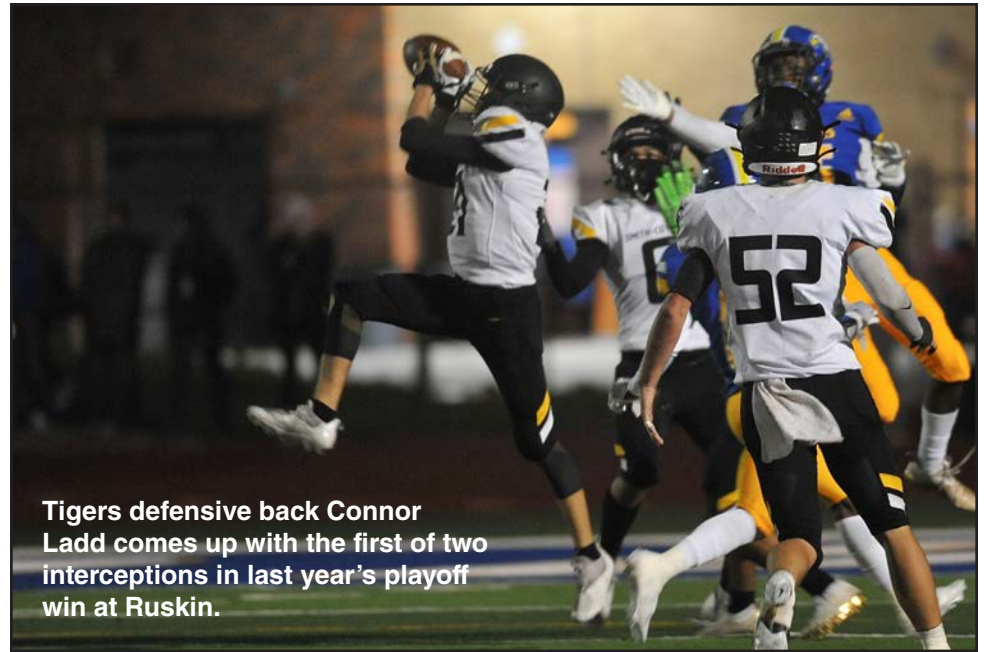

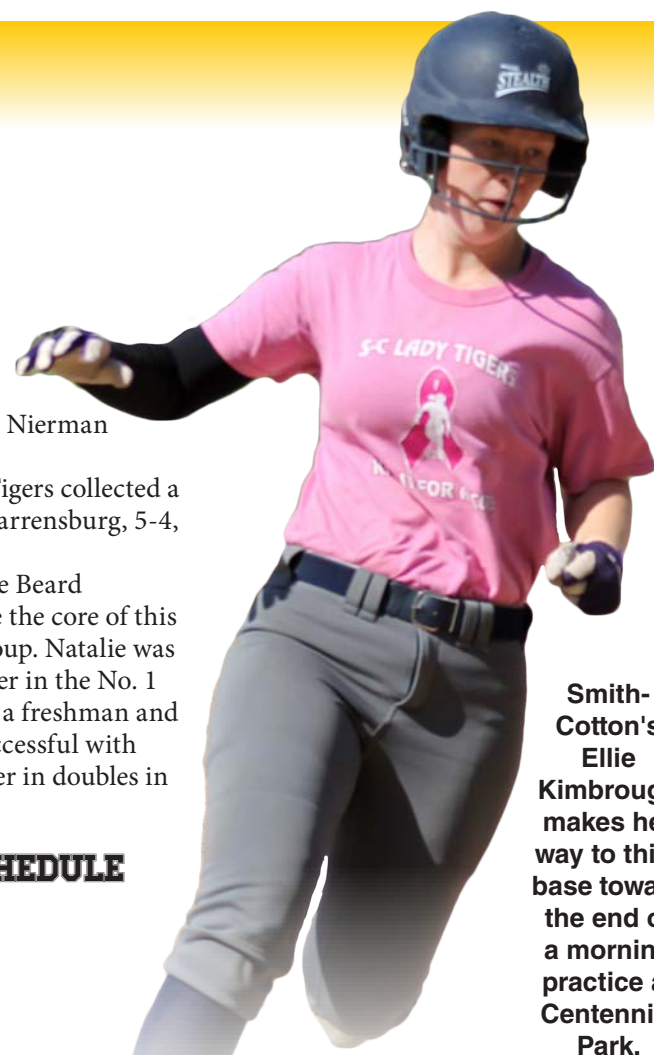

KAYSINGER

Kaysinger Conference: What to Watch

In recent seasons, the Kaysinger Conference has seen its member schools achieve at the highest levels in fall sports.

Between the lines, Lincoln and Windsor football have had incredible success in the postseason, with the Greyhounds lifting the Class 1 state title. Stover and Sacred Heart have been among the standouts on the volleyball court. These programs and more have gone beyond being great in just the surrounding counties.

Here's a look at some of the programs, athletes, and storylines to watch this fall.

SMITHTON IN SOCCER AGAIN

For years, it was Sacred Heart's place at the top of the Kaysinger Conference, and it wasn't really close. The Gremlins were a symbol of excellence.

Things have become much more interesting, even while Sacred Heart remains very much a great program in

itself. A talented group came through Smithton in the past few years. In 2019, the Tigers got the best of Sacred Heart at the conference tourney, but the Gremlins got revenge, 4-1, later in the year. The next season, Sacred Heart again couldn't be touched, getting the better of Cole Camp, a strong challenger, too.

Last fall, Smithton took control, winning both games, including a 2-1 conference tournament final. This year, it looks like it could be a competitive battle between the two at the top of the Kaysinger yet again. The Gremlins bring back an extremely talented junior class, while Smithton senior Braedon Cairer might be the best player and can change the fate of the game with his abilities.

WHO CAN MATCH STOVER SH IN VOLLEYBALL

The Lady Gremlins and Bulldogs were stellar in 2021.

For Stover, its only losses all year were to Eugene (in five sets), Class 3 state champion Blair Oaks and Conway in sectionals. At the Kaysinger

Tournament, Sacred Heart defeated Smithton, Green Ridge, La Monte and Cole Camp in straight sets before losing in three to Stover. Credit to Cole Camp for getting back at the Gremlins three days later in Benton County, but for the most part, it was a two-team race.

Could that change this year? Will Cole Camp step forward as its girls did in softball? The cabinet isn't empty for either of last year's favorites despite names like Kiley Beykirch and Amyjah Belt graduating.

CROSS COUNTRY STANDOUTS

Some of those names who excelled in Jefferson City at the state track and field meet are naturally going to be making waves with cross country back in full swing.

State champion Riley Bryan is back for one more season to run the Class 1 scene. It wasn't even close last year. As a junior, Bryan's final time was 18:27.6. By comparison, second-place finisher Addison Barringhaus from Glasgow ended in 20:20.9, nearly two minutes behind. That was

nearly the kind of difference between Barringhaus and Bryan's teammate, Paige Murray, who came in within the top-60. It's Bryan's race to lose, seemingly. On the boys' side also from Smithton, Gabe Aitken was in the top-40, ending with a time of 18:15.6. He'll have two more seasons to cut down and improve on that mark.

Stover's Blaine Broderson, also a breakout on the basketball court, found himself in the finals of multiple long-distance events for track, making him one of those ideal crossover candidates. At Gans Creek Course last fall, Broderson finished in the top-20 with a time of 17:09.1. He could be one expected to take another step forward as a senior.

EVERYONE CHASING WINDSOR FOOTBALL

The Greyhounds have taken the ball in the Kaysinger and run with it in the past few seasons, with most teams they've lined up against not even able to hold a candle to them.

With a new head coach in Chuck Speer and even more

talented players needing to be replaced, including a pair of big-time Witherspoons, Dylan and Dalton -- there's still one left, Payton -- can Windsor remain at the top?

It's going to be awfully difficult. Lincoln's only defeats last season came to top programs, Windsor included in a 42-20 defeat, but the Cardinals have a staggering 18 starters coming back, including quarterback Connor Lynde, tailback Ross Johnson and the team's entire line. That's a scary prospect.

Behind those two, Cole Camp gave Lincoln a run for its money in the pair of games the rivals played at the end of the year, and the Bluebirds can beat you in different ways with many of the same players. Not to be forgotten, Tipton also brings back its share of players and only lost by nine to Lincoln last year. The partnership with the I-70 Conference that has all these teams playing a full schedule of common opponents will make for gauging them all even more fascinating.
