Warrensburg is a thriving community of just over 20,000 residents. As the regional hub of a 6-county area and home to the University of Central Missouri and nearby Whiteman Air Force Base, Warrensburg is well positioned for continued economic growth. Warrensburg's centralized location, its affordable business climate and its sophisticated small-town appeal have provided tremendous growth momentum recently.

From small friendly boutiques to large retail stores and unique antique shops, there is something for everyone to enjoy. The Warrensburg business community offers over 70 restaurants / bars and approximately 100 retailers. Recent additions of new companies such as Marshalls, Hy-Vee, Starbucks, Casey's General Stores, Fazoli's, Factory Connection, Culver's Restaurant, and Firehouse Subs show that businesses and residents alike recognize the wonderful assets Warrensburg has to offer.

This recent growth has also had a positive impact on employment and the

Journey Home is a network hub of collaborative community partners who provide homeless individuals and those at risk of becoming homeless with the opportunity to access resources and support (for example: assistance with housing, employment, and access to legal documents like IDs and Birth Certificates) that will lead to sustained safe, adequate, and permanent housing and employment.

A service provided by Journey Home, the Johnson County Resource Center (JCRC) is currently open on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8am-2pm, as a safe and welcoming space for individuals to come and hang out. Free breakfast and lunch is provided and individuals can connect with staff and volunteers for general support, case management, housing help, and community resources.

Additionally, Journey Home offers services through The Shop, which gives donations of furniture, household goods, hygiene products, and more for FREE to individuals in need. The Shop is open Tuesdays afternoon from 1-4pm and Saturdays from 9am-12pm.

All of our projects are available to help individuals who are homeless, individuals who are at risk of homelessness, people in the rehousing process and any one in the community who may find themselves in need.

JUST THE FACTS

No matter where your travel plans take you, Warrensburg, Missouri is on the way. Located in the center of the country's heartland, Warrensburg is an hour's drive from Kansas City, four hours from St. Louis, and three hours from Branson, Missouri. Warrensburg residents are in the enviable position of being able to enjoy the attractions of metropolitan areas and the advantages of small-town life. Unlike purely suburban areas, Warrensburg is a self-contained city with a vibrant employment base, active cultural scene, and many civic events and activities. Warrensburg serves as the county seat of Johnson County.

Established in 1855, Warrensburg is a third-class city, with a council-manager form of government adopted in 1957. Its five council members are elected at-large, and one council member is selected by the council to serve as mayor.

The City of Warrensburg provides police, fire, street maintenance, sewer, animal control, building inspection, and planning and zoning services within the city limits, as well as maintaining the Sunset Hill Cemetery. Warrensburg is home to 9 beautiful parks covering over 400 acres, including 3 award-winning parks – Cave Hollow, Grover Memorial and Shepard Park, miles of hiking trails, a skate park, dog park, 8 tennis courts, 6 pickleball courts, 6 playgrounds, 7 ballfields, 2 soccer fields, Nassif Aquatic Center and the Warrensburg Community Center, which features a full size gymnasium with 6 basketball goals, a Walking Track, the Indoor Aquatic Facility, 7 meeting rooms, and the award-winning WCC Fitness Center! The Community Center also provides space for the Senior Center that operates a weekday lunch and home delivery program. The City operates with over 280 full-time, part-time, and seasonal employees.

JOHNSON COUNTY COMMUNITY HEALTH SERVICES (JCCHS)

Established in 1975, Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) is led by an elected Board of Trustees and serves as the County Health Department with three programs essential to health and wellness.

Public Health promotes and protects the health of individuals, families, communities, and populations. Our focus is on preventing disease and injury by promoting a healthy lifestyle. Services include immunizations, health screenings and a variety of health tests including sexually transmitted diseases, tuberculosis, pregnancy, and lead. JCCHS also offers CPR/AED and First Aid, child-care provider support, car seat safety, safe

cribs, and disease case management.

JCCHS is responsible for environmental public health and resources. Sanitation and safety inspections for food establishments, child-care facilities and lodging establishments performed annually. JCCHS also administers regulations for the design and construction of all on-site wastewater treatments systems in Johnson County.

JCCHS Home Health promotes independence and recovery in the home setting through skilled nursing, therapy, and social services. JCCHS offers specialized care to those recovering from surgery or have conditions requiring regular medical care in the comfort of their home.

WIC services provide essential nutritional needs and education. This includes supplemental food, health care referrals, nutrition education, and breastfeeding promotion and support. Fathers, grandparents, guardians, and foster parents may also apply for benefits for children living in their household.

JCCHS works collaboratively with area community groups to address a wide range of health care needs to eliminate health disparities and increase the number of healthy years that Johnson County residents live.

WHITEMAN AIR FORCE BASE

Sixty miles southeast of Kansas City, nestled among the wooded, rolling hills of west-central Missouri, two miles south of Knob Noster, is the bustling community of Whiteman Air Force Base. Whiteman is the home of the 509th Bomb Wing, proud to serve as host to several associated units. These include the Air Force Reserve 442d Fighter Wing, Missouri Army National Guard 1-135th Assault Helicopter Battalion, Missouri Air National Guard 131st Bomb Wing, and the 20th Attack Squadron.

509th Bomb Wing Mission

The 509th Bomb Wing is part of Air Force Global Strike Command and is the host wing at Whiteman Air Force Base, Mo. The Bomb Wing and its fleet of B-2 Spirit bombers serve as part of the Air Force's conventional and strategic combat force. The Bomb Wing can project U.S. airpower anywhere around the world from its home station and employ a wide range of



precision-guided munitions. The 509th Bomb Wing comprises approximately 5,600 military

members and 2,000 civilian employees. The mission statement of the 509th Bomb Wing is "Execute Nuclear Operations and Global Strike ...Anytime, Anywhere!"

B-2 Spirit Bomber

The B-2 Spirit Bomber is a multi-role bomber capable of delivering both conventional and nuclear munitions. By possessing an extreme unrefueled range and the ability to penetrate deep into enemy airspace undetected and unassisted, the B-2 can place any fixed or movable target at risk and expose the aircraft crew to limited hostilities.

Air Force Reserve's 442d Fighter Wing

The 442d Fighter Wing is comprised of nearly 1,800 members at WAFB and two geographically separated units; the 917th Fighter Group, Barksdale Air Force Base, LA., and the 476th Fighter Group, Moody Air Force Base, GA. The wing is responsible for the combat readiness of 48 A-10 Thunderbolt II aircraft – all the A-10s in the Air Force Reserve. The 442nd moved to Whiteman from Richards-Gebaur Air Force Base, Kansas City, Mo., in June 1994.

A-10 Thunderbolt II

The A-10 Thunderbolt II is a single-seat fighter jet designed to provide close air support for ground forces by attacking tanks and other armored vehicles.

Army National Guard's 1-135th Assault Helicopter Battalion

The Missouri National Guard is the only component of the armed forces that has two missions. The federal mission is to provide federal support when called upon by the president – this could be for overseas contingency operations or national emergencies like Hurricane Katrina. Their mission is to support the governor of Missouri in times of state crisis. The 1-135th Assault Battalion's mission is to conduct attack, reconnaissance, and security operations that complement other maneuver forces. They control AH-64 Apache Helicopters.

AH-64 Apache

AH-64 Apache is the Army's heavy division/corps attack helicopter. The Apache conducts rear, close, and shaping missions including deep precision strikes. It also conducts distributed operations, precision strikes against relocatable targets, and provides armed reconnaissance when

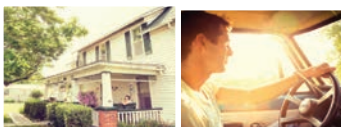

required in day, night, obscured battlefield and adverse weather conditions. The combination of the radars, advanced navigation and avionics suite of the aircraft provide increased situational awareness, lethality and survivability.

Air National Guard's 131st Bomb Wing

In 2008, Whiteman AFB welcomed the Missouri Air National Guard's 131st Bomb Wing into its midst as an associate B-2 unit. In this capacity, Missouri's citizen-aimen work alongside active-duty personnel to maintain and fly the nation's most advanced bomber.

Whiteman Air Force Base History

Whiteman's heritage dates back to 1942, and U.S. Army Air Corps officials selected the current site as the home of Sedalia Army Air Field. Following the war's end, the airfield remained in service as an operational location for Army Air Force C-46 and C-47 transports. In December 1947, the base was inactivated.

However, in 1951, the Strategic Air Command selected the base to be a site of one of its new bombardment wings, with both bombers and tankers assigned. In 1952, SAC activated the 340th Bombardment Wing. In 1955, members of the wing saw the base name change to Whiteman Air Force Base in honor of 2nd Lt. George A. Whiteman. Whiteman was one of the first American airmen killed in combat during World War II when his P-40 fighter, the Lucky Me, was shot down. In the 1960s its mission shifted from aircraft to the Minuteman Intercontinental Ballistic Missile. In 1961 officials selected the base to become the command's fourth Minuteman missile wing, the 351st Strategic Missile Wing.

In 1987, Congressman Ike Skelton announced the B-2 Advanced Technology Bomber would be based at Whiteman AFB. In preparation for a second wing, the Air Force activated the 100th Division in July 1990 to

replace the 351st as the base host unit. Thus, in July 1991, the 100th was inactivated, and the 351st again assumed its host unit role. The changes did not end there. On July 31, 1991, President George H.W. Bush signed the historic Strategic Arms Reduction Treaty (START) that called for the dismantling and destruction of the Minuteman II ICBMs.

The end of the Cold War spelled the end of the 351st, and the deactivation of the Minuteman II system began immediately. On January 8, 1993, the wing's first launch control center, India-01, shut down operations. In 1995, the last Minuteman II missile, located at Juliet-03 in Chloe, Johnson County, was removed from its site.

The 509th Bomb Wing traces its historical roots to its World War II ancestor, the 509th Composite Group, which was formed with one mission: to drop the atomic bomb. The group made history on August 6, 1945, when the B-29 Enola Gay, piloted by

Paul W. Tibbets, Jr., dropped the first atomic bomb on Hiroshima, Japan.

On September 30, 1990, the 509th BW was transferred to Whiteman AFB and, in July 1993, accepted host responsibilities for the base. During this same month, the wing received its first fixed-wing aircraft, a T-38 with a B-2 style paint job.

On December 17, 1993, the 90th anniversary of Orville Wright's historic first successful, controlled, heavier-than-air powered flight at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina, the world's most sophisticated and advanced aircraft, the B-2 Advanced Technology Bomber Spirit of Missouri, arrived at Whiteman AFB.

Members of the Warrensburg Chamber of Commerce Military Affairs Committee continue to support and connect with the Airmen of their sister squadrons, the 509th Operations Support Squadron, 393rd Bomb Squadron, and the 20th Attack Squadron.

WARRENSBURG R-6 SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Warrensburg School District, founded in 1866, is located in Johnson County, Missouri, just an hour's drive from Kansas City, Missouri. The population within the District is 26,244. The District employs 567 staff members who serve 3,500 PreK-12th grade students on seven campuses. Over 60 percent of the District's teachers hold advanced degrees, averaging over 13 years of classroom experience. The average student-to-classroom-teacher ratio is 16 to 1, and Warrensburg R-VI District is fully accredited by the State Board of Education.

With Purple Star Schools, the District has dedicated liaisons to support our military families and students in each school. These liaisons support relocation, deployment, loss, academic planning, and eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.

Warrensburg is a 1-to-1 technology school district. Students in PreK through 2nd grade receive an iPad, 3-8 grade students receive a Chromebook, and high school students are issued laptop or Chromebooks. A District Technology Specialist is available to assist students and teachers with technology integration as are library tech aides in each building. Additionally, the District employs Instructional Coaches at each building to enhance instruc-

tion and student learning.

The District has four elementary schools housing PreK-5th grade students, including preschool, early childhood special education, full-day kindergarten, and before and after-school child care programs. Each elementary school has a media center and offers Project Lead the Way curriculum, art, music, and physical education by fully certified staff members and services for students with special needs. Staff supporting the education process in each building include a principal, assistant principal, school nurse, social worker, counselors, and title teachers at each elementary. As students move to the middle school level, students have opportunities to participate in band, sports, and numerous after-school clubs.

High school students can take advantage of the A+ program opportunities, dual credit, Project Lead the Way classes, advanced placement classes in various subjects, and courses in robotics, biomedicine, and broadcasting. Students can participate in the University of Central Missouri Innovation Track, earning college credit by attending classes on campus or online. Numerous extra and intra-curricular activities are also available to encourage students to participate fully in their high school experience.

Preparing Johnson County students and adults for rewarding careers is possible through the Warrensburg Area Career Center. The Center offers programs in technology information management, computer programming, nursing, automobile mechanics, agriculture, building trades, office technology, and cosmetology. Program additions are expected in the future following the completion of the new construction trades building.

The Gateway Educational Center provides opportunities for sophomore through senior students to earn credits towards graduation in an alternative setting. These students also participate in service-learning programs combining an academic curriculum with meaningful community service. The Tiger's Den, supplying items such as food and clothing for students in need, is another example of our students' work to give back.

Through the years, the city of Warrensburg and the surrounding areas have been great supporters of the District. Their support has allowed facility additions and improvements, including classrooms at several buildings and a Warrensburg Activities Complex. These partnerships and the patron support of the school district make Warrensburg a great place to raise a family!

STATE FAIR COMMUNITY COLLEGE (SFCC)

State Fair Community College (SFCC), accredited by the Higher Learning Commission, serves 14 counties in west central Missouri. Nearly 10,000 students enroll annually in both credit and continuing education programs at locations in Sedalia, Boonville, Clinton, Eldon, Lake of the Ozarks, Warsaw, and Whiteman Air Force Base, with options for online or on-campus classes.

HERITAGE



Warrensburg's exciting future remains anchored to its colorful frontier past. The town's history dates back to 1833 when Martin Warren arrived from Kentucky and settled along the Osage Indian Trail. In 1834, the county of Johnson was designated, and the town of Columbus was the center of county government until 1836. In 1838, a group of early Missouri leaders, including Daniel Morgan Boone, chose the site for the county courthouse in the growing village that was to become Warrensburg. The county court commissioned the building of the courthouse in that same year, and it took four years to complete. Incorporation as a city came in 1855, and the railroad arrived in 1864. A thriving new commercial district sprouted along the tracks, five blocks southeast of the original town (or town square), and nearby sandstone quarries helped spur growth.

Important historical sites maintained by the Johnson County Historical Society on old Main Street include the 1838 Old Courthouse, Mary Miller Smiser Heritage Library and Museum, the Johnson County Courthouse (now over 100 years old), and the restored 1890s train depot that houses The Greater Warrensburg Area Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center offices. Preserving our past has become a focus for our community and the Johnson County Historical Society.

One of our parks, located in the city's historic area, has been restored and is now known as Blind Boone Park. The completed restoration includes a gazebo for public musical events, picnic areas, and a statue of Blind Boone. J.W. "Blind" Boone was a beloved member of our community who, blind and of multi-ethnic heritage, succeeded in working past many physical, cultural and economic limitations to become a famous concert pianist.

Another citizen's group has formed to preserve Howard School, one of the oldest and the most historically significant black schools in Missouri. These two exciting projects enhance the work already accomplished by the Johnson County Historical Society.

Old Drum, our beloved hunting dog mascot, is one of the most celebrated figures from Warrensburg's past. When U.S. senator-to-be George Graham Vest delivered his eulogy to the dog in 1870 in a Johnson County courtroom, he had no idea his words would make him famous. His words, coining the phrase "Man's best friend is his dog," quickly won him fame across Missouri and beyond. Vest made the speech while arguing in court on behalf of Charles Burden, whose favorite dog was shot by the ward of Leonidas Hornsby. Burden sued and the case eventually wound up in the Missouri Supreme Court where the plaintiff was awarded \$50. The trial advanced

Vest's political career, and in 1958 his Tribute to a Dog was cast in bronze beneath the statue of Old Drum on the courthouse lawn. Vest's eulogy has won world fame and has been cited as one of the greatest speeches given during the 19th-century. The story of Old Drum is known and loved the world over.

The Johnson County Historic Complex on the west side of town is home to several unique structures. The historic 1838 courthouse is one of a few examples of Federal-style architecture west of the Mississippi River. This stucco-covered brick building was restored to its former beauty during the early 1960s. The courthouse has been the scene of a pre-civil war murder, a daring raid for the purpose of stealing/preserving the county records throughout the war between states, and the Old Drum Trial in 1870. The defense's clos-

ing argument was a moving speech about the dedication and loyalty of dogs, and is said to be the origin of the phrase "A dog is a man's best friend."

Other buildings on the property include the Miller Smiser Heritage Library (built in 1982 to exhibit a collection of materials concerning county history, family genealogy, and newspapers); the Zinn and Leland Culp Building (farm machinery and household artifacts illustrating the agricultural roots of the area), the Culp Building is available to rent for meetings and other functions; and the One Room School (built in 1911 and moved from Elm, Missouri to the Historical Society grounds in 1995).

A TRIBUTE TO THE DOG

By George Graham Vest

"Gentlemen of the jury: The best friend a man has in this world may turn against him and become his enemy. His son or daughter that he has reared with loving care may prove ungrateful. Those who are nearest and dearest to us, those whom we trust with our happiness and our good name, may become traitors to their faith. The money that a man has, he may lose. It flies away from him, perhaps when he needs it the most. A man's reputation may be sacrificed in a moment of ill-considered action. The people who are prone to fall on their knees to do us honor when success is with us may be the first to throw the stone of malice when failure settles its cloud upon our heads. The one absolutely unselfish friend that a man can have in this selfish world, the one that never deserts him, and the one that never proves ungrateful or treacherous, is his dog."

"Gentlemen of the jury: A man's dog stands by him in prosperity and in poverty, in health and in sickness. He will sleep on the cold ground, when the wintry winds blow and the snow drives fiercely, if only he may be near his master's side. He will kiss the hand that has no food to offer, he will lick the wounds and sores that come in encounters with the roughness of the world. He guards the sleep of his pauper master as if he were a prince. When all other friends desert, he remains. When riches take wings and reputation falls to pieces, he is as constant in his love as the sun in its journey through the heavens. If fortune drives the master forth an outcast in the world, friendless and homeless, the faithful dog asks no higher privilege than that of accompanying him to guard against danger, to fight against his enemies, and when the last scene of all comes, and death takes the master in its embrace and his body is laid away in the cold ground, no matter if all other friends pursue their way, there by his graveside will the noble dog be found, his head between his paws, his eyes sad but open in alert watchfulness, faithful and true even to death."

friends or just by yourself, this picturesque park is the perfect spot to soak in the beauty of the fall season.

Blind Boone Park, a beautiful tribute to renowned jazz pianist and composer John William "Blind" Boone, is in the city's historic area. It features a 20-foot pavilion with electricity, a life-size steel and bronze sculpture depicting Boone, a 13-foot-tall wind harp, plants native to our area, and a sensory garden for the visually impaired. Other amenities include a reflexology walkway, rope pathways, type, Braille, audio information signs, ADA-approved bathrooms, wheelchair-accessible picnic tables, and a shuffleboard court. J.W. track located 3.5 miles north of Warrensburg off Highway 13. The season runs from April through September.

If you are looking for places to gather and enjoy outdoors,

Knob Noster State Park is eight miles east of Warrensburg between Whiteman Air Force Base (WAFB) and Warrensburg. The park encompasses over 3,500 acres and offers fishing, camping, biking trails, hiking trails, covered pavilions, picnic areas, an equestrian trail and camp, RV parking, playgrounds, and restroom facilities.

The park has a nature center with exhibits, several small lakes, a small stream, and many trails for exploring. Connecting Warrensburg to Knob Noster and WAFB, the **Spirit Trail** is 10.3 miles long from Warrensburg to Hwy DD. Within the park itself, the trail is 4.4 miles long. The trail is day-use only, and parking areas are available at **Clearfork Day Use Area**, **WPA Day Use Area**, and **McAdoo Trailhead**. Depending on the conditions and special events, the trail may be closed to bicycles and equestrian users.
